6 Fishing

Fishing lochs are easily accessible with permits available from the local newsagent. Loch Tay Fish 'N' Trips offer boat hire, guided boat trips or full ghillie fishing.

Cycle up Glen Lochay (you may see a Golden Eagle) or the try the woodland trails starting at the old station.




