



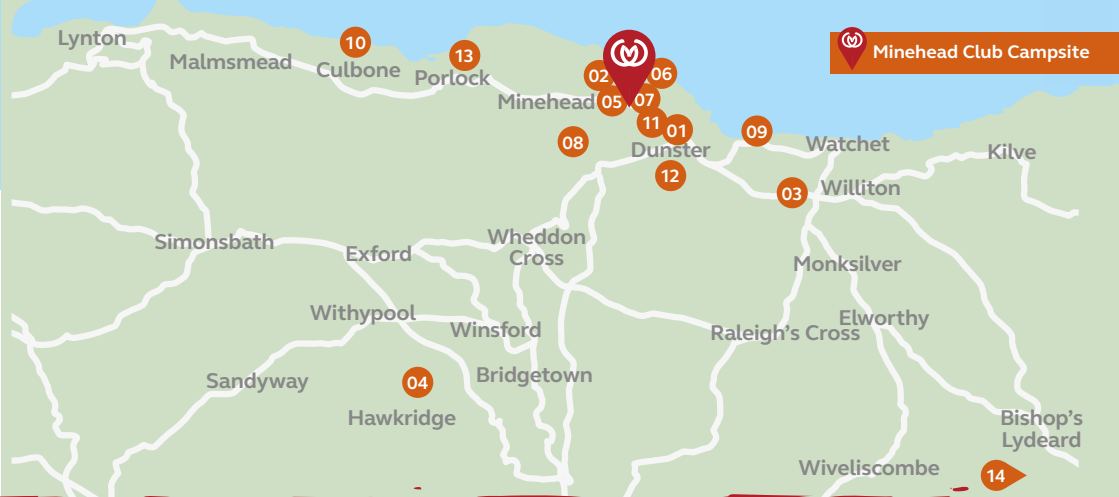

## Visit

- 1 **Dunster Castle and Working Watermill**  
17th century castle and gardens, with picturesque watermill.
- 2 **West Somerset Railway**  
A heritage steam railway between Minehead and Bishop's Lydeard.
- 3 **Cleeve Abbey**  
One of the undiscovered jewels of Somerset, Cleeve Abbey is a haven of peace and tranquility.

- 4 **Tarr Steps**  
Ancient clapper bridge and great place to explore Exmoor National Park.
- 5 **Minehead Eye**  
An indoor park for scooting, skateboarding, BMX, and roller or inline skating.
- 6 **Golf**  
Minehead and West Somerset Golf Club is a great classic links course set against the Brendon Hills with captivating sea views.
- 7 **Leisure Centre**  
5 minutes walk from the site, with a wide range of facilities, racket sports and exercise classes.



## Cycle

### 10 National Cycle Network

The nearest route to the site is Regional Route 51, The Culbone Way.

### 11 Local routes

You can follow the cycle route to Dunster, or cycle in Exmoor, just a short drive away.

## Walk

### 8 Exmoor National Park

Explore the stunning landscapes and wilderness with wild red deer and native Exmoor ponies.

### 9 Local routes

Enjoy walks from the site to Dunster Castle, Minehead and Watchet. The South West Coast path starts just a mile away. Maps are available in reception.



## Explore

### 12 Dunster

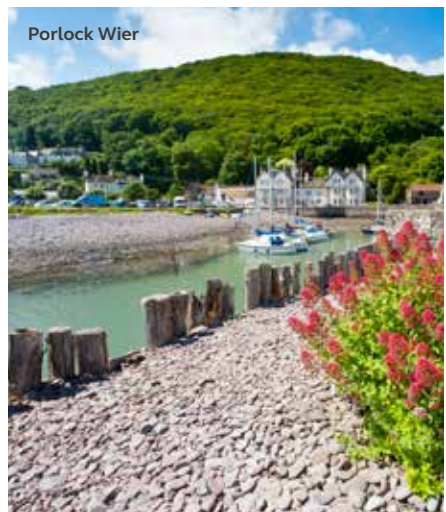
A medieval village with an ancient castle and over 200 listed buildings.

### 13 Porlock Weir

Picturesque hamlet, once a busy port, with a pretty harbour for yachts and fishing boats.

### 14 Taunton

1,000 years of history, including a 10th century monastery and Taunton Castle.





## Visitor's top tips

There is a beautiful walk at Bossington which follows a stream through woodland to the old Coastguard lookout. Don't miss the beautiful views of Porlock Bay.

Visit Lynton and Lynmouth via Porlock Hill.

The Dunster Show is a great day out each August.


The Beach, the coastal path and Dunster are all within walking distance, so leave the car and enjoy the fresh air.

Dunster beach is fabulous and dog friendly with good parking and facilities.

The coastal walk alongside the Minehead & West Somerset Golf Club to Dunster village is a very pleasant, easy walk. A visit to the picturesque village and its castle is an enjoyable day.

Lovely little place called Watchet just up the coast which has a lovely harbour and a great dog friendly café which was most welcome on a cold day in February! It also has two spaces for motorhome parking.

Terrific local cycling routes, can be hilly!

Selworthy flower festival in summer is lovely.

Bus stop (5 minutes walk) goes to Minehead and Taunton. From Minehead buses go to Porlock and Dulverton. There is also a steam train which goes to Watchet and Bishops Lydeard.
