Pitch care

Awning ground sheets must be lifted daily.

Motor caravans

Barbecues

These are allowed on site but open fires are not. Please keep barbecues off the grass.

TV & Radio reception

Television reception is good. The EHU bollards do not have a TV socket.

Toilets and showers

The toilet block is closed for cleaning at the times shown on the block doors.

There is a parent and toddler bathroom for children up to 4 years old.

Please ensure that children are supervised by an adult at all times.

The disabled toilet and shower facilities need a key, which is available from Reception on arrival.

Laundry

Prices for the use of the laundry facilities are:
Washing machine £3.00,
Tumble drier 70p/cycle,
Spin drier 20p/cycle.
Washing sinks and ironing boards are also available.

Please do not hang washing lines between trees or on the fences.

Safety on Site

Vehicles and cycles

For the safety of all, please obey the speed limit of 5mph when driving on site. Foot peddled cycles, scooters and skateboards can be used, with care, but are not allowed on the paved area around toilet blocks and communal areas and must not be ridden on footpaths. Please note motorised mobility scooters are allowed on site, but children's motorised scooters and motorised skateboards are not. Parents are reminded that children remain their responsibility at all times, and to ensure that all members of their party follow the principles of road safety.

Pets
