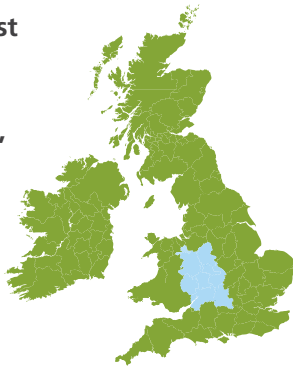

Castle Combe

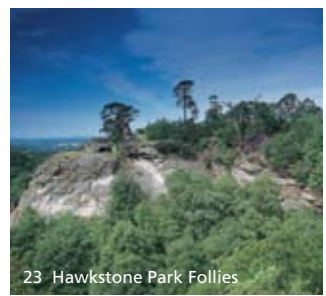

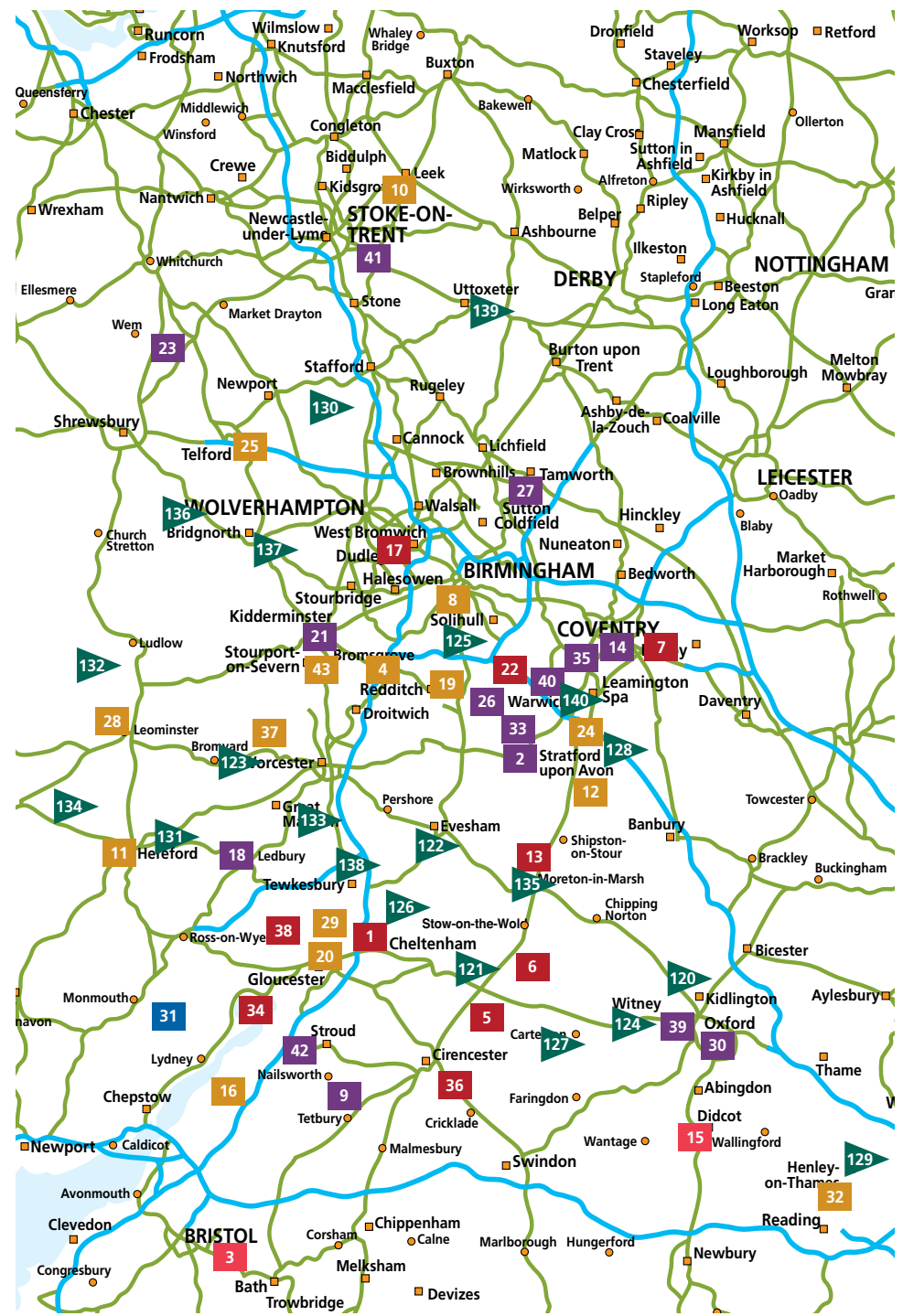
