Get to know your site

This is a gracious site in a former garden with magnificent specimen trees. There is a choice between pitches in open areas or in small groups surrounded with shrubs – the rhododendrons are a riot of colour in the spring.

The site is located close to the 1066 Trail in this delightful area of East Sussex, which will appeal not only to walkers and nature lovers, but to discerning families wishing to escape the crowds

on the coast; yet the seaside towns of Eastbourne, Hastings and others are just a short drive away.

Battle is a small, bustling town with interesting shops and a visit to the Abbey, built to commemorate the Battle of Hastings is a must. Nearby Rye, a Cinque Port, is a picturesque town with castle and cobbled streets and there is a wealth of National Trust and English Heritage properties to visit in the surrounding area.

Reception Services

Reception opening hours

See reception for opening times.

Mail and messages

Mail and messages are put on the board at reception.

Site shop

See reception for opening times. The shop sells various items including gas, milk, eggs, sweets, chocolates, ice-creams and toilet chemicals. Orders are taken for newspapers.

Pitches

Pitch care

Levelling blocks are required in some area's on this site. Please lift awning ground sheets daily.

Motorhomes

If your pitch is left unoccupied, please leave your motorhome sign on display.

Vacating your pitch

If you wish to stay after 12 noon on your day of departure, please check with reception.

Barbecues

These are allowed on site but open fires are not. Please keep barbecues off the grass.

TV reception

As part of the Digital Switchover, this region has had its analogue television signal switched off. In order to watch television on site you will need an Integrated Digital TV (IDTV) or a digital receiver, and you may also need an aerial or satellite dish. For more information ask your warden or visit www.digitaluk.co.uk. The EHU bollards do not have a TV socket.

Electric hook-up

The costs of electricity are included in your pitch fee, but please help us minimise our effect on the environment by considering your electricity use while on site. Also any saving could help to reduce pitch fees or help towards investments in new sites or redevelopments.

Toilets and showers

Closing times are displayed at the toilet blocks. The disabled toilet and shower room is located in the top toilet block. Access is by Radar key only. The baby and toddler room is located in the lower toilet block. Entry by key only, available from reception.

Laundry

There is a laundry room in both toilet blocks. Prices for the use of the laundry facilities are: Washing machine £4.00, Tumble drier £1.00, Rinse & Spin £1.00 per 15min cycle. Washing sinks are also available. Please do not hang washing lines between trees or on the fences.

Play areas

There is a play area for ball games and a playground on site. Please ensure that children are supervised by an adult at all times.

Safety on Site

Vehicles and cycles

Parents are reminded that children remain their responsibility and therefore they should be supervised at all times, and to ensure that all members of their party follow the principles of road safety.

Motor vehicles and bicycles on site should, at all times, be used with due regard to the safety and convenience of others and their speed should not exceed walking pace (5mph). No cycling is permitted on site between the hours of dusk and dawn, as determined by the Wardens. Any one-way system signs should be observed by all vehicles and cycles. Foot pedalled cycles, scooters and skateboards can be used, but are not allowed on the paved area around toilet blocks and communal areas and must not be ridden on footpaths. Please note that motorised mobility scooters are allowed on site, but children's motorised scooters or skateboards are not.

Pets

Please keep your dog on a lead at all times on the pitching areas and roads within the site, and clean up after them. Dogs can be walked on a lead off-site on the public footpath adjoining the site – 1½ miles to Catsfield village.

Fire point

(to activate alarm/warning) Located at all service points.

Security barrier

There is a security barrier on site. A card is required for the barrier which is issued on arrival.

Visitors

Please ask your visitors to make themselves known at reception when arriving at the site. If you are expecting visitors after hours, please meet them at reception. Please note only one car is allowed per pitch.

Overhead power cables

There are overhead cables that have warning signs near the play area.

Rabbit holes

Please be aware of the rabbit holes on site.
