Activities

• Cycling

Cycling is suggested on the Millennium Cycle path within 2 miles of the site and there are also routes around the Swansea and Mumbles cycle path. Information is available from the office and Information Room. The nearest National Cycle Network route to this site is Greenwich to Fishguard, Route 4, OS ref S5579969.

Get to know your site

This is a level, well-designed site within a short drive from the stunning Gower Peninsular with its beautiful clean and sandy beaches, fabulous walking and quaint villages and pubs.

There is something for everyone on the Gower whether it's a day by the sea, pleasant coastal walks or exciting water sports. Plenty of beaches for families and surfers on the peninsular, Rhossili and Oxwich being particular popular.

Swansea offers a traditional market and shopping centre with great museums and visitor attractions. Swansea Bay with its expansive sands, boasts a trim track and excellent beach side cafes and coffee

shops. On the far side of the bay you will find the famous Mumbles and Oystermouth with the Life Boat Station, quirky shops and slipway access for boats.

Further inland you can explore the Vale of Neath to Aberdulais Falls, and see how the waters have powered a succession of industries over three hundred years. Then on to Craig Gwladys where you can walk the forest trails and climb the steep ascent with the hang-gliders soaring above you. On again to Pont Nedd Fechan, from where you can see nine major waterfalls on four rivers, then into the Brecon Beacons National Park which is worth a holiday all on its own.

Reception services

Mail and messages

Mail and messages are put on the board outside the office.

Reception opening hours

9am - 6pm from May Day weekend until August Bank Holiday. Outside these dates, opening hours are displayed on the office door.

Site shop

Open at the same times as reception. The shop sells toilet chemicals, gas, newspapers, ice cream, sweets and a small selection of provisions.

Pitch care

Please lift awning ground sheets daily.

Motorhomes

If your pitch is left unoccupied, please leave your motor caravan sign on display.

Vacating your pitch

If you wish to stay after 12 noon on your day of departure please ask at reception.

Barbecues

These are allowed on site but open fires are not. Please keep barbecues off the grass.

TV reception

As part of the Digital Switchover, this region has now had its analogue television signal switched off. In order to watch television on site you will need an Integrated Digital TV (IDTV) or a digital receiver, and you may also need an aerial or satellite dish. Electric hook-up

The costs of electricity are included in your pitch fee, but please help us minimise our effect on the environment by considering your electricity use while on site. Also any saving could help to reduce pitch fees or help towards investments in new sites or redevelopments.

Site facilities

Toilets and showers

The toilet blocks are closed for cleaning from 10.20am - 12.30pm. The individual cleaning times for the Ladies and Gents are displayed in the shower block, the Information Room and the laundry.

There is a baby and toddler bathroom for children under 4 years old. Keys are available from reception. Please ensure that children are supervised by an adult at all times. The disabled toilet and shower facilities are located in the toilet block, with a RADAR key needed for the door locks.

Laundry

Prices for the use of the laundry facilities are: Washing machine £4.00, Tumble drier £1.00, Rinse & Spin £1.00 per 15min cycle. Washing sinks are also available. Please do not hang washing lines between trees or on the fences.

Recycling

On site for bottles, paper, cardboard, plastics and cans.

Ball games and kites

No ball games or kite flying are allowed on site.

Safety on site

Pets

Please keep your dog on a lead at all times on the pitching areas and roads within the site. You are welcome to use the woodland dog walk to exercise your dog. Please don't forget to clean up after them.

Fire point

(to activate alarm/warning) Located outside the office and at each service point.

Vehicles and cycles

Parents are reminded that children remain their responsibility and therefore they should be supervised at all times, and to ensure that all members of their party follow the principles of road safety.

Motor vehicles and bicycles on site should, at all times, be used with due regard to the safety and convenience of others and their speed should not exceed walking pace (5mph). No cycling is permitted on site between the hours of dusk and dawn, as determined by the Wardens. Any one-way system signs should be observed by all vehicles and cycles. Foot pedalled cycles, scooters and skateboards can be used, but are not allowed on the paved area around toilet blocks and communal areas and must not be ridden on footpaths. Please note that motorised mobility scooters are allowed on site, but children's motorised scooters or skateboards are not.

Visitors

Please ask your visitors to make themselves known at reception when arriving at the site. If you are expecting visitors after hours, please meet them at reception. Visitors cars must be parked in the visitors car park.

Close by

Access to the adjoining ELBA Sports Ground and local shops and pubs is through a gated path which also allows cyclists safe passage to Swansea Bay (6 miles) and the Gower.

Supermarkets

The closest is Tesco Express within a short walk.

Cinema

There are three cinemas (Odeon, Vue and UCI) in Swansea, about 7 miles from the site.
