From the site entrance a 2 miles walk will bring you to the beach and where you can join the coastal path. Mansands Beach is a vigorous 2.5 mile walk (remember it's uphill on the way back!).

- **Swimming pool**
The swimming pool is open from end of May – mid September (depending on weather conditions). Normal pool opening times are 10am – 6pm (please check notice boards for exact opening times). It may be necessary to run timed session at busy periods. A lifeguard is on duty when the pool is open, however children under 16 years must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
 - **Restaurant and Bar Complex**
The complex includes Nico's Restaurant, a bar and evening entertainment area, and a family games room. Nico's offers a variety of freshly cooked meals including evening meals, a children's menu, light bites as well as a take-away service and a delicious carvery on Sundays (please check with staff early or late season). Get to know your site

Set in 22 acres of Devon countryside, this site offers some of the finest facilities on the network in a great location with many pitches affording stunning views of the sea.

There's plenty of entertainment: an outdoor heated swimming pool, children's pool, play area and an indoor complex housing a games room, shop, bar & restaurant serving meals as well as a takeaway service.

Evening entertainment, particularly in peak season, and a whole range of themed events and special activities are scheduled throughout the season.

Further afield there are miles of safe sandy beaches. An 18-hole golf course, pitch and putt, tennis, fishing, sailing, steam railway trips and a zoo are all within easy reach. Brixham is less than 2 miles away.

Pitch care

Please lift awning ground sheet daily.

Motorhomes

If your pitch is left unoccupied, please leave your motorhome sign on display.

Vacating your pitch

If you wish to stay after 12 noon on your day of departure, it is normally not a problem unless the site is fully booked. Please enquire at reception.

Barbecues

These are allowed on site but open fires are not. Please keep barbecues off the grass.

TV reception

As part of the Digital Switchover, this region has now had its analogue television signal switched off. In order to watch television on site you will need an Integrated Digital TV (IDTV) or a digital receiver, and you may also need an aerial or satellite dish. Wi-Fi

Electric hook-up

The costs of electricity are included in your pitch fee, but please help us minimise our effect on the environment by considering your electricity use while on site. Also any saving could help to reduce pitch fees or help towards investments in new sites or redevelopments.

Site facilities

Toilets and showers

The toilet blocks are closed for cleaning at the following times:

Upper Block: 10.30am to 12.30pm.

Lower Block: 2.30pm to 4.30pm.

Disabled toilet and shower facilities are located in both toilet blocks. Access is with a RADAR key. There is a baby and toddler bathroom for children under 4 years old and family shower rooms for children aged 7 years and under. Keys are available from reception on payment of a £5 deposit.

Please ensure that children are supervised by an adult at all times.

Laundry

Laundry is located in the toilet blocks. Prices for the use of the laundry facilities are:

Washing machine £4.00, Tumble drier

£1.00, Rinse & Spin £1.00 per 15min cycle.

Washing sinks are available. Please do not hang washing lines between trees or on the fences.

Play areas

There is a play area for ball games and a playground with play equipment. Please ensure that children are supervised by an adult at all times. For safety reasons, the play area should only be used during daylight hours.

Recycling facilities

On site for glass, plastic, cans, paper and cardboard. Other facilities at Sainsbury's car park in Paignton.

Safety on Site

Pets

Please keep your dog on a lead at all times on the pitching areas and roads within the site, and clean up after them. Dogs can be exercised in the fenced top field, beyond the children's play area.

Fire point

(to activate alarm/warning) Located at each service point, reception and entertainment complex.

Vehicles and cycles

Parents are reminded that children remain their responsibility and therefore they should be supervised at all times, and to ensure that all members of their party follow the principles of road safety.

Motor vehicles and bicycles on site should, at all times, be used with due regard to the safety and convenience of others and their speed should not exceed walking pace (5mph). No cycling is permitted on site between the hours of dusk and dawn, as determined by the Wardens. Any one-way system signs should be observed by all vehicles and cycles. Foot pedalled cycles, scooters and skateboards can be used, but are not allowed on the communal areas and must not be ridden on footpaths. Please note that motorised mobility scooters are allowed on site, but children's motorised scooters or skateboards are not.

Security barrier

There is a security barrier onsite. A code is given to new arrivals when booking in. For security reasons please do not disclose the entry codes to the site.

Please ask your visitors to make themselves known at reception when arriving at the site.
