Toilets and showers

There is a baby and toddler bathroom for children under 4 years old. Keys are available from Reception (refundable deposit payable). Please ensure that children are supervised by an adult at all times.

The disabled toilet and shower facilities are located in the toilet block, with a RADAR key needed for the door locks (refundable deposit payable).

Laundry

Prices for the use of the laundry facilities are: Washing machine £3.00, Tumble drier 70p/cycle. Washing sinks and an ironing board are also available.

Please do not hang washing lines between trees or on the fences.

Ball games and kites

No ball games or kite flying are allowed on site.

Safety on Site

Vehicles and cycles

Motor vehicles and bicycles on site should, at all times, be used with due regard to the safety and convenience of others and their speed should not exceed walking pace (5mph). Any one-way system signs should be observed by all vehicles and cycles. Foot pedalled cycles, scooters and skateboards can be used, but are not allowed on the paved area around toilet blocks and communal areas and must not be ridden on footpaths. Please note that motorised mobility scooters are allowed on site, but children's motorised scooters or skateboards are not. Parents are reminded that children remain their responsibility at all times, and to ensure that all members of their party follow the principles of road safety.

Pets

Please keep your dog on a lead at all times on the pitching areas and roads within the site, and clean up after them. Dogs can be walked in the dog walk on site.
