Site Shop

The shop sells Gas, maps, milk, eggs and other basics and also has a small library. A fresh fish van calls on site on Fridays at 8.45am and a butcher occasionally at 10.00 am.

There are also weekly markets throughout the area.

Pitches

Pitch care

Breathable ground sheets only and must be lifted daily if on grass pitches.

Motor caravans

If your pitch is left unoccupied, please leave your motor caravan sign on display.

Vacating your pitch

If you wish to stay after 12 noon on your day of departure, please ask at Reception.

Barbecues

These are allowed on site but open fires are not. Please keep barbecues and anything hot off the grass.

Toilets and showers

The toilet blocks are closed for cleaning at the following times:

11.00am - 12.30pm

Please ensure that children are supervised by an adult at all times.

The disabled facilities are located at the toilet block. RADAR keys are available from Reception (a deposit is required).

Please do not hang washing lines between trees or on the fences.

Recycling facilities

These are available on site for newspapers, plastic bottles, glass and cans.

Games

Please note that ball games are not allowed in the vicinity of outfits. Soft play balls and other games are available to borrow.

Safety on Site

Vehicles and cycles

Motor vehicles and bicycles on site should, at all times, be used with due regard to the safety and convenience of others and their speed should not exceed walking pace (5mph). Any one-way system signs should be observed by all vehicles and cycles. Foot pedalled cycles, scooters and skateboards can be used, but are not allowed on the paved area around toilet blocks and communal areas and must not be ridden on footpaths. Please note that motorised mobility scooters are allowed on site, but children's motorised scooters or skateboards are not. Parents are reminded that children remain their responsibility at all times, and to ensure that all members of their party follow the principles of road safety.

Pets

Please keep your dog on a lead at all times on site, and clean up after them. There is no dog walk on site. The Wardens have information about nearby walks for dogs. Even out of the site, dogs must be on a lead and under control at all times as sheep and cattle graze in nearby fields (some beaches have bye-law restrictions - information is available at Reception).
