You need to contact the campsite you wish to stay at, who will quote you a price for the campsite fees and ferry crossing, once you have confirmed your booking the Jersey authorities will issue you a permit. For the moment Guernsey does not accept caravans, and motor caravans can only be taken to the Island if they have a permit and are less than 6.9 meters long. Trailer tents can be taken on the island without restrictions.

If you would like to take a motor caravan to Guernsey you must contact the campsite of your choice who will arrange your site booking and permit.
