**Folding Camping** Picnic Table This is a pretty straightforward little table

## **Regatta Deluxe Folding Camping Chair**

This is one of the highest quality items here – Regatta takes the concept of the basic telescopic chair and improves upon it. You certainly wouldn't want this on your back during a day-long hike on a hot day, and it's not immediately obvious how it erects properly, but it's supremely comfortable, boasting a thickly-padded base and backrest, plus curved, aluminium armrests. The headrest folds back – perfect for those mid-afternoon snoozes. The chair folds down to a reasonably compact size and comes with its own carry bag.



Comprising nothing more than a simple oblong worktop and a pair of detachable scissor legs, assembly seems to require the 'brute force' approach. Turn the tabletop over and align the legs with the rather flimsy slots in its base – go for the ones at either end if you require a low table, or either side if you need a little more height. Getting things to marry then involves pressing your foot against the leg and bearing down with your weight. It feels inexpensive – the top in particular reminded us of plastic garden furniture - but it's a clever solution to multiheight requirements.
