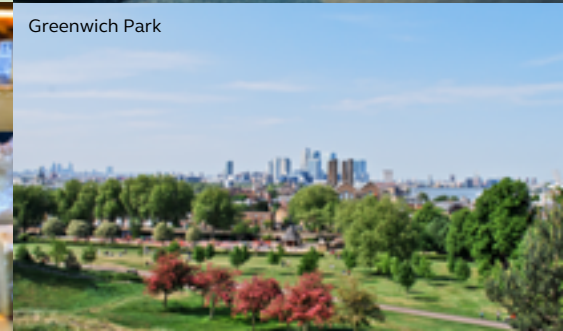
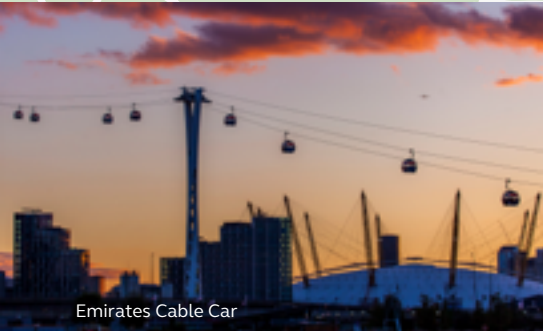
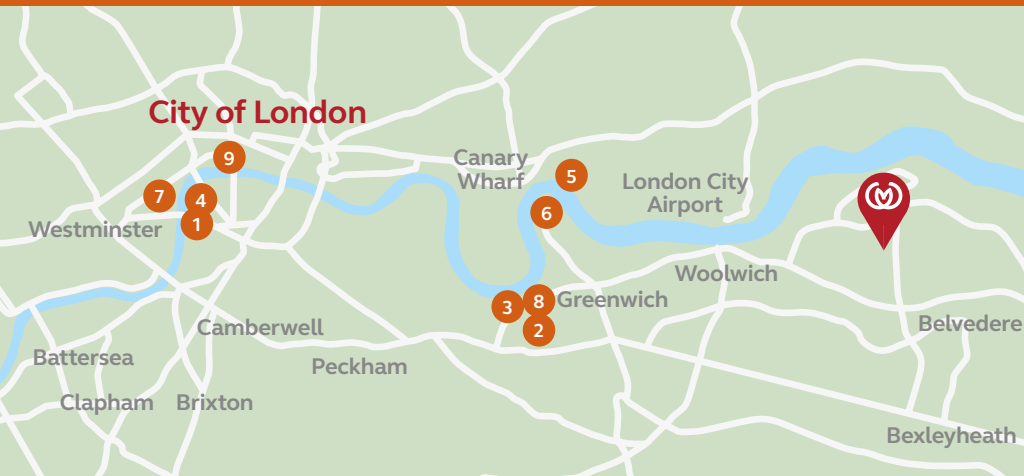

Things to do

1 The London Eye

A 135 metre-tall cantilevered observation wheel on the River Thames. With 32 glass capsules, it rotates continuously at a walking pace to offer 360-degree views.

2 The Old Royal Observatory

Britain's oldest purpose-built scientific institution. The birthplace of modern astronomy, home of Greenwich Mean Time and the exact location of the Prime Meridian.

3 Cutty Sark

A British extreme clipper ship and a celebrated museum. Famous for speed, she was designed for the China tea trade.

4 The London Dungeons

An immersive walk-through experience that brings 1,000 years of London's darkest history to life with actors, sets, special effects and a ride.

5 London Cable Car

The UK's first urban cable car, transporting passengers 90-metres above the River Thames between the Greenwich Peninsula and the Royal Docks.

6 Up at The O2

A thrilling 90-minute roof-walking experience over the iconic O2 arena. Strap into a harness, clip onto a safety rail and scale a bouncy walkway up to an observation platform.

7 Thames Rib Experience

High-speed boat tours through the heart of London. Aboard 12-seater Rigid Inflatable Boats and speeds of up to 30 knots with guided sightseeing past iconic landmarks.

8 Greenwich

A historic district famous for its maritime history, Royal connections and as the home of Greenwich Mean Time. Also part of a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

9 London

The bustling capital and largest city of England and UK. On the River Thames, just 30 minutes by train, this leading global powerhouse in finance, arts and culture is home to over 9 million residents.

Walk

Easy access to the Green Chain Walk, including a section from Lesnes Abbey Wood to the Thames Path.

Neighbouring Lesnes Abbey Wood has over 80 hectares of ancient woodland and the ruins of the 12th Century Abbey to explore.

Cycle

A mixture of on-road and traffic-free routes surround the site, Greenwich and the neighbouring Borough of Bexley have a great selection of parks that are ideal for cycling.

The nearest National Cycle Network route is The Thames Path which is part of Route 1.
