Hall and gardens set in 50 acres of parkland with spectacular views.
- 2 Scarborough**

Built in 1598 and surrounded by lawns, topiary, Yew bushes and woodland garden.

Visitor's top tips

Bridlington Coast

Visit the RSPB reserve at Bempton to see puffins.

There are 2 pubs within 1 mile walking distance, both serve home cooked food and are reasonably priced.

Walk or drive to Danes Dyke beach, 1.5 miles away (there's pay & display parking) great for dog walks and enjoying the tea shack!

Excellent walk through Sewerby to Bridlington, either via the shore or the cliff-top path.

The views around the lighthouse at Flamborough head are beautiful!

North Landing, Thorwick Bay, sewerby, great walks and don't forget the speedboat rides!

Lovely walks from site in any direction taking in Flamborough, the lighthouse, South landing, Danes dyke and Sewerby or North from Flamborough to Bempton cliffs and beyond.

Visit Bridlington Priory Church, in the old town to see where the Dad's Army film was set.

Don't miss Bridlington Spa Theatre for concerts, events and shows throughout the year.
