Arrival and Reception

Approach Route

- Access onto the site is via a long driveway
- Follow the access road round and the reception building is to the left
- Gate, barrier?
- The ground around this area has a tarmac access road to the reception

Parking

- A new arrival bay is set within a few metres of the Reception building.
- There is a gravelled car park for visitors within 25 metres of the reception building, there is space for 8 vehicles. There are no designated disabled bays
- There are no late night arrival bays, so all arrivals must be before 8pm

Entrance into Reception

- There is a concrete ramp that gives access to Reception (gradient of 1:15)
- There is an alternative stepped approach with a single handrail
- The Entrance door is 720mm wide with a level threshold
- The entrance door is not power assisted, and opens (direction?)
- There is no call bell to the door

Reception

- There is approximately 600mm x 1500mm turning space in front of the reception desk
- The reception desk is set 940mm above the floor with no lower level
- The desk is not fitted with a hearing loop

Getting around the Site

- The site slopes at various points throughout, the east of the site has roads that include gradients of 1:20 and the west of the site includes roads with gradients of 1:12
- Pedestrians share vehicles routes which are a mixture of tarmac and gravel roads
- There are a small number of pedestrian footpaths around the site

Pitches

- There are 142 pitches on site, 96 of which are hardstanding
- Roll out mats are not provided
- There are no designated accessible pitches, however pitches are allocated according to your needs or preference, so please contact us in advance to discuss your requirements.
- There are 26 fully serviced pitches on site
- There are 11 pitches that are relatively level, within 40 meters of the toilet block, including 4 fully serviced pitches. These pitches are to the east of the site.

Camping Pitches

- There are 23 tent pitches with electric hook up
- There are 6 tent pitches without electric hook up

Toilets and Changing Facilities

Accessible Toilets and Bathing Facilities – Toilet Block

- A combined Accessible Toilet and Shower cubicle is located in the Toilet Block which is adjacent to the reception
- The accessible toilet is accessed via the ramp to reception
- The door is 850mm wide, over a level threshold
- The cubicle door is secured by RADAR key. A key can be borrowed from Reception
- The cubicle's overall dimensions are 1450mm x 2200mm
- The WC pan is right hand transfer.

- There is no pull down shower seat, but there is a free standing shower chair
- The toilet seat is ?mm, and the shower seat is ?mm above the floor level
- The clear space to the side of the toilet is ?mm wide
- The cubicle is fitted with a pull cord alarm, which is tested frequently
- The shower seat and WC Pan are fitted with grab rails to assist transfer
- Shower controls are ?mm high
- The shower head is fitted on a sliding rail, which is a minimum of ?mm above floor level
- The basin taps and shower controls are fitted with levers

Standard Toilets and Washrooms

- There is one toilet and shower block, which is adjacent to the reception
- Parking is available within 40 meters of the block
- Entrance doors to the male and female toilets are to the rear of the toilet block, and are 750mm wide, over a 15mm threshold
- Each male and female area has ? shower cubicles and ? washbasin privacy cubicles
- There is unisex toilets to the front of reception with showers, the entrance door is 560mm wide. There is a 260mm step up to the shower cubicles.
- There is unisex toilets to the rear of the reception with showers, the entrance door is 760mm wide with a 15mm threshold. There is a 170mm step up to the showers. There are only thumb turn taps in here.
- Lever taps/controls?

Family Washroom

- There is a family restroom to the front of the building
- The entrance door is 560mm wide
- Dimensions?
- There is a 260mm step up into the shower?
- There are lever controls?

Other Facilities

Dishwashing – External

- There is a covered open fronted canopy (where?)
- There are ? counter mounted sinks at 900mm with 760mm kneespace
- Lever taps available

Laundry and Dishwashing Room – Adjacent to Reception

- Access?
- The door is 680mm wide over a level threshold
- The room is 1250mm wide?
- There is a ?loading washing machine, with coin slots at ?mm
- There is a ?loading tumble dryer, with coin slots at ?mm
- There are ? counter mounted sinks at 930mm with no knee space beneath
- Lever taps fitted

Information Room – Adjacent to Reception

- Access is via a stepped approach with no handrails
- The door is 900mm wide with a 15mm threshold
- The room's dimensions are ?
- There is 1100mm clear space internally
- Information is displayed between 400mm and 1400mm

Dog Walk Pathways

- There are a few dog walk pathways around the site
- These have grass and wood chip flooring
- These are accessed via gates, with controls at 900mm high
- The pathways are at various gradients throughout, these exceed 1:12

Bar and Restaurant

- There is a bar and restaurant within the reception block on the first floor

- This is accessed via an external staircase with handrails
- The entrance door is 930mm wide with a 230mm step up
- The inner lobby door is 800mm wide
- The room is open plan with a range of furniture
- The bar is 1100mm high, with no lower section
- There is no hearing loop fitted at the bar

Service Points

- There are Service Points at various intervals around the site, please check the site map for details
- All of the service points are on raised concrete settings?
- The paths around the Service Points can be as narrow as 750mm wide
- The water taps are at a maximum of 1050mm high, with cross head taps
- Chemical Waste Points can be found here too

- There is one Motorhome Waste Point on site, located close to the reception block
