



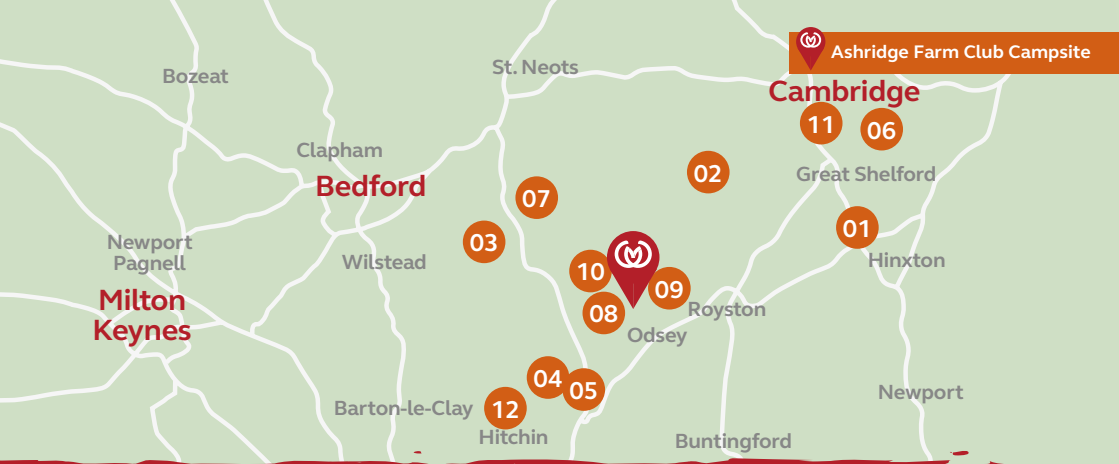

- 1 **Duxford Imperial War Museum**

- 4 **Shuttleworth Collection**

### 10 Ashwell

Historic village with 14th century church, pretty cottages and local shops.

### 11 Cambridge

Quirky town, home to ancient colleges, leafy spaces and the famous river.

Pretty market town with medieval layout, historic buildings and traditional cobbled streets.





## Visitor's top tips

Great walk into the village for a meal at one of the many lovely pubs (many are dog friendly), or a visit to local shops. There are great butchers and bakers.

You can purchase fresh free-range eggs from the farm stall down the lane from the site.

Pick up a map of the village from reception.

Royston Heath is also nearby – great place to exercise dogs with a nice cafe.

There is an excellent farm shop within easy walking distance of the site. We were surprised by the range and quality of food and non-food items on sale.

Visit the RSPB Lodge Nature Reserve. It's the largest stretch of heathland in Bedfordshire and we had a wonderful day out.

There is a lovely little church in the village which is worth a visit.

### Shop

Ashwell, 0.6 miles.
