Things to do

1 Duxford Imperial War Museum

Britain's largest aviation museum, set on a historic First and Second World War airfield, with aircraft, military vehicles and artillery – the home of the Spitfire.

2 Wimpole Hall

A 3,000-acre estate with spectacular 17th Century mansion. The grounds include a working rare breeds farm, parklands and walled kitchen garden.

3 Standalone Farm

A working farm and popular, family destination offering hands-on experiences with farm animals, daily activities and countryside trails.

4 Shuttleworth Collection

An aviation and automotive museum, unique because exhibits are kept airworthy. Featuring the world's oldest flying aircraft, vintage cars, bicycles and veteran vehicles.

5 Karting Nation – Letchworth

A 700 metre indoor go-karting circuit featuring tight bends and straights designed to test skill levels. For all age racers, complete with a spectator gallery.

6 Punting Tours

Punt along the River Cam through the heart of Cambridge and enjoy fantastic views from the water of the famous Cambridge College Backs.

7 RSPB The Lodge

The national headquarters of the RSPB and a 220-hectare nature reserve, featuring the county's largest stretch of heathland.

8 Ashwell

A picturesque village on the edge of the Chiltern Hills. With a unique medieval street pattern, timber-framed buildings and the impressive 14th Century St Mary's Church.

9 Cambridge

A world-renowned university city on the River Cam. Famous for stunning Gothic architecture and lush green spaces, it blends centuries of academic heritage with a thriving, modern high-tech economy.

10 Hitchin

A highly sought-after market town renowned for medieval and Georgian architecture, vibrant shop and café culture and a strong community spirit.

Walk

The surrounding area is a haven for walkers, pick-up a walking guide from reception for more information.

Cycle

The nearest National Cycle Network route is 12: Potters Bar to Sandy. There are also plenty of quiet cycle routes through Ashwell and the surrounding villages.
