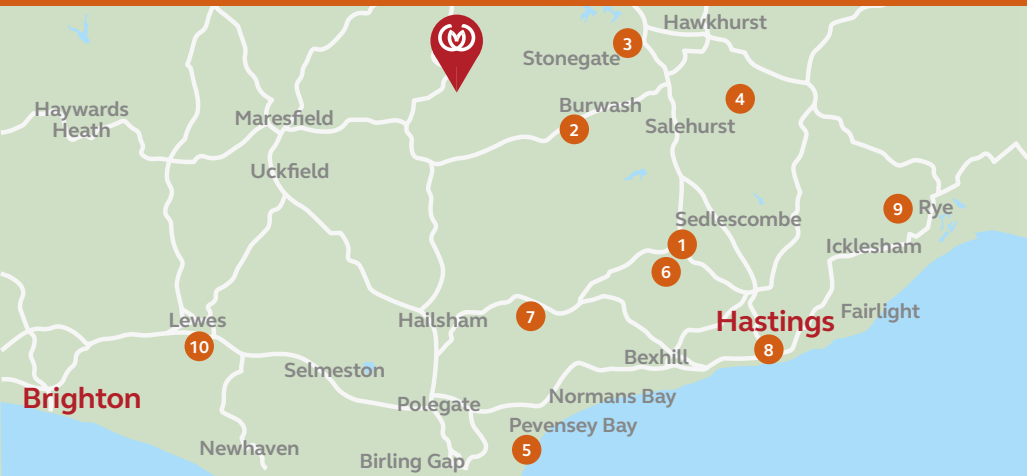

Things to do

1 Battle Abbey

A partially ruined monastery to commemorate the Battle of Hastings. Located on Senlac Hill, the high altar was purposefully placed where King Harold is believed to have died.

2 Bateman's

A 17th Century sandstone house, famous as the beloved family home of author Rudyard Kipling, complete with a working watermill remaining preserved as the family left it.

3 Pashley Manor Gardens

Set against a Tudor-Georgian manor is one of the finest gardens in England. Celebrated for its seasonal floral displays – dazzling spring tulips and late-summer dahlias.

4 Bodiam Castle

One of Britain's most iconic medieval fortresses, famed for its fairytale aesthetic, symmetrical design and wide moat, constructed to defend against the French invasion.

5 Watersports

The beaches at Eastbourne, Pevensey and Hastings are popular for sailing, rowing and windsurfing.

6 Wylands Angling Centre

One of the UK's best angling centres, with 9 well-stocked lakes offering day and night tickets for specimen and pleasure anglers.

7 Herstmonceux Castle and Science Centre

A 15th Century moated Castle surrounded by woodlands, meadows and gardens. Alongside interactive science exhibits and telescopes at the astronomical observatory.

8 Hastings

A historic seaside town renowned as the 1066 Norman landing site. It blends a narrow-streeted Old Town with Victorian architecture, a mix of maritime heritage, culture and coastal scenery.

9 Rye

A charming hilltop town with a jumbled network of steep cobbled lanes and unique historic buildings.

10 Lewes

Dotted with boutique shops and antique centres, this historic town has Lewes Castle, Anne of Cleves House and the Harvey's Brewery.

Walk

The 1066 trail is a great, interesting walking route that can be picked up from the site.

With beautiful coastal landscapes and spectacular views of the Seven Sisters, Birling Gap is the perfect place for a relaxing wander, or a more challenging route along the South Downs Way.

Cycle

The nearest National Cycle Network route is 2: Dover to Newhaven, part of the Garden of England cycle route.

The nearest cycle path is the Cuckoo Trail, about 15 miles from site.

A scenic 30 minute cycle to the charming Bexhill-on-Sea – an elegant and pretty seaside town famous as the birthplace of British motor racing.

- ✓ TV reception – fair. Booster or external aerial required
- ✓ Club Wi-Fi. Premium wifi – *charges apply*. Free wifi to the pitch
