#### **Visit**

**1** Leeds Castle

Set in 500 acres of beautiful parkland with adventure playground, falconry, gardens, vineyard, Go Ape and Segway.

2 Hop Farm Family Park

Family attraction including adventure play area, live magic shows and animal farm.

3 Bredgar and Wormshill Light Railway

Steam locomotives, traction engines, model railway and vintage vehicles.

Chatham Historic Dockyard

Explore the world's most complete dockyard of the age of sail.

Fishing

Fish at Major Lakes (1 mile) or Monks Lakes (12 miles).

Running between Aylesford and Barming Bridge, this serene river ride soaks up the beautiful sights and sounds of the riverbank.





# Visitor's top tips

When visiting Leeds Castle show your membership card to receive a discount on admission price.

From the bus stop outside the gate, the 10X goes to Maidstone for some retail therapy, Ashford outlet is also nearby.

Walk to Bearsted Green for a drink or a meal in the dog-friendly pub 'The Oak on the Green'.

Tenterden Steam Railway is well worth a visit. as well as Tenterden itself.

Definitely visit Canterbury, it's a beautiful city with a stunning cathedral, lots of history, cafés and shops and is under an hour's drive away. The Bearsted Woodland Trust walk is very pleasant.

Visit the National Trust's Chartwell House, which is Churchill's former house – definitely worth the drive!

The Potting Shed Restaurant is lovely, and is only a 10-minute drive away.

Chatham and Dover Castle are fantastic days out.

The George Inn in Leeds Village is a wonderful pub with excellent food and friendly staff.
