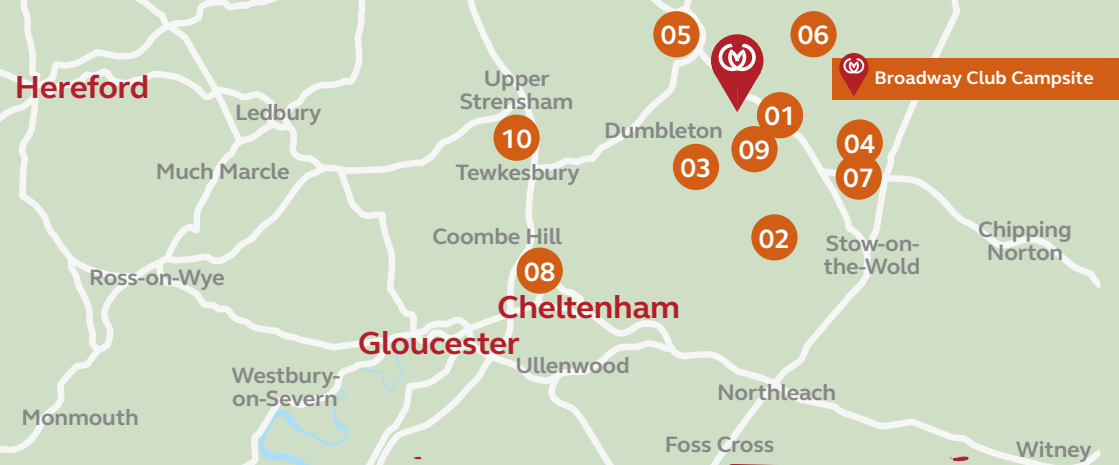

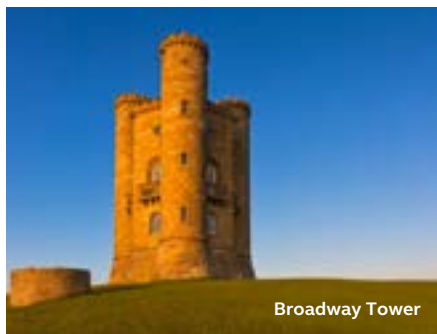

## Visit

- 1 **Broadway Tower**  
A dramatic folly by Capability Brown, with views over 13 counties.
- 2 **Cotswold Farm Park**  
Rare farm animal breeds, seasonal demonstrations and children's activities.

- 3 **Gloucestershire Warwickshire Railway**  
Now at Broadway Station, enjoy 25 miles of Cotswold countryside and the famous Sanway viaduct.
- 4 **Cotswold Falconry Centre**  
See eagles, hawks, owls, vultures and falcons being flown, and get to hold these impressive birds.
- 5 **Evesham Leisure Centre**  
A great indoor activity hub with swimming pools and climbing wall.



## Walk

### 6 Cotswold Way

Running close to the site, this scenic trail offers 100 miles of magical walks through picturesque villages and stunning scenery.

### 7 Batsford Arboretum

Explore 55 magical acres of woodland, gardens, wild flowers, caves and waterfalls.

### 8 National Cycle Network

The nearest route to the site is 41, Rugby to Bath.

### 9 Snowhill Manor

A breath-taking manor house filled with spectacular treasures, surrounded by gorgeous gardens.

### 10 Tewkesbury

With a rich, vibrant history and a beautiful waterside setting, there is plenty to discover here. Stroll beside the River Severn, or perhaps enjoy a boat trip along the Avon. Explore the Abbey, museums, shops and boutiques.

## Visitor's top tips

**II** Take advantage of the well signed local footpaths and beautiful countryside.

A walk to the Broadway Tower through the fields is a must, there's a café at the top to rest!

Broadway village is absolutely beautiful, with nice places to eat and shop it's a 'must see'.

Don't miss The Wanderer, the unique horse-drawn caravan built for Dr William Gordon Stables, the first vice-president of the Club.

Russell's Fish and Chips is excellent.

The Broadway Hotel is a 15-minute walk from site. It welcomes dogs into the bar which is great for an afternoon drink after a walk.

There is a great little market garden shop in Broadway selling fresh fruit and vegetables.

Chipping Camden is worth a visit, it is such a beautiful place.

Hop on the steam train to Cheltenham Racecourse for a beautiful journey.

There is a cashpoint at Co-op, 0.6 miles from the campsite.

A bus service (hail & ride) from the site entrance to Moreton-in-Marsh, Stratford Upon Avon and Chipping Camden.
