At a Glance



Level Access

- The site is relatively level throughout



Step only Access

- The defibrillator room has a 120mm step in
- The play area has a 120mm step down



Accessible Toilets and Showers

- There is a combined accessible toilet and shower cubicle in the toilet block



Accessible Pitches

- No designated accessible pitches, however pitches are allocated according to your needs or preference, so please contact us in advance to discuss your requirements.

Arrival and Reception

Approach Route

- Access onto the site is via a narrow road, which has a traffic light system before the entrance to help flow of traffic.
- The reception building is on the left hand side when you enter the site
- Access into the site is controlled via a vehicle barrier controlled by card access.
- The ground is level in this area with hard surfaced paths linking facilities.

Parking

- A new arrival bay is set within a few metres of the Reception building.
- There is space for 6 cars to park opposite Reception, however there are no marked bays or disabled bays. The ground in this area is tarmacked, however there is a slope up to reception
- There are no late night arrival bays on site

Entrance into Reception

- There is a dropped curb to the path around reception
- The Entrance door is 750mm wide and with a 60mm threshold
- The entrance door is not power assisted, and opens outwards



Reception

- There is approximately 2500mm x 2200mm turning space, clear of the desk and furniture
- The reception desk is set 900mm above the floor with no dropped section
- The desk is not fitted with a hearing loop



Getting around the Site

- The site is generally set relatively level throughout
- Pedestrians share vehicles routes which are well maintained tarmac, but do incorporate speed bumps

Pitches

- There are 99 pitches on site, all of which are hardstanding
- Temporary multipurpose access rubber matting is not provided
- There are no designated accessible pitches, however pitches are allocated according to your needs or preference, so please contact us in advance to discuss your requirements.
- There are 2 hardstanding pitches and pitches within 50 meters of the toilet block
- There is one pitch closer to reception that is within 100 meters of reception
- Pitches are allocated according to need/preference. Please contact us in advance to discuss your requirements.

Toilets and Changing Facilities

Accessible Toilets and Bathing facilities – Toilet Block

- A combined Accessible Toilet and Shower cubicle is located in the Toilet Block which is set to the centre of the site.
- The toilet block is accessed via a shallow paved slope
- The door is 800mm wide, over a level threshold and opens outwards
- The cubicle door is secured by RADAR key. A key can be borrowed from Reception
- The cubicle's overall dimensions are 2100mm x 2700mm
- The WC pan is left hand transfer.
- The shower seat is right hand transfer
- The toilet seat is 480mm, and the shower seat is 460mm above the floor level
- The clear space to the side of the toilet is 1400mm wide
- The cubicle is fitted with pull cord alarms, which are tested frequently
- The shower seat and WC Pan are fitted with grab rails to assist transfer
- Shower controls are 1000mm high

- The shower head is fitted on a sliding rail, which is a minimum of 1400mm above floor level
- The basin taps and shower controls are fitted with levers



Accessible Toilet Cubicle - Toilet Block

- There is an accessible toilet cubicle in the Toilet Block, which is set to the centre of the site
- There is a dropped kerb to the pathway around the toilet block, which gives access to the Accessible Toilet Cubicle
- The door is 800mm wide, over a level threshold and opens outwards
- The cubicle door is secured by RADAR key. A key can be borrowed from Reception
- The cubicle's overall dimensions are 1600mm x 2450mm
- The WC pan is right hand transfer
- The toilet seat is 480mm above the floor level
- The clear space to the side of the toilet is 800mm wide
- The cubicle is fitted with a pull cord alarm, which is tested frequently
- The WC Pan is fitted with grab rails to assist transfer
- The basin taps are fitted with levers



Standard Toilets and Washrooms

- There is one toilet and shower blocks at the centre of the site
- Entrance doors are accessed by a paved area, which is accessed via a slight paved slope
- The female area in the Toilet Block has 7 WC cubicles, 7 Shower cubicles and 3 Washbasin Privacy cubicles
- The male area in the Toilet Block has 4 Urinals, including 1 lowered Urinal, 4 WC cubicles, 7 Shower cubicles and 3 Washbasin Privacy cubicles
- The male and female facilities can be closed in halves to allow some facilities to remain open during cleaning
- There is a modified WC cubicle, Shower cubicle and Washbasin Privacy cubicle in both the male and female areas in both male and female facilities, with handrails to assist mobility
- Taps in each area incorporate lever controls



Inclusive Room - Toilet Block

- There is an inclusive bathroom in the Toilet Block which can be accessed via the dropped kerbs to the pathway around the toilet block
- The door is 800mm wide, over a level threshold and opens outwards
- The room's dimensions are 2800mm x 1800mm
- There is a half sized bathtub with a shower above, this has lever turn taps to operate
- The toilet seat is 430mm high
- There is a drop down baby change table at 900mm high
- There are lever turn taps to the basin
- There is a shower, with controls at 1000mm high and a shower head on a sliding rail between 1400mm and 1900mm
- There is a shelf at 750mm high



Other Facilities

Dishwashing and Laundry Room – Toilet Block

- The dishwashing and laundry room can be accessed via the path around the toilet block
- The door opens to 800mm wide over a rollover threshold and opens inwards
- There is 1600mm x 1500mm clear space within the room
- There are 3 sinks in an 880mm high counter with 550mm knee space below
- There is a front loading washing machine and a front loading tumble dryer
- Lever taps available



Drying Room – Adjacent to Toilet Block

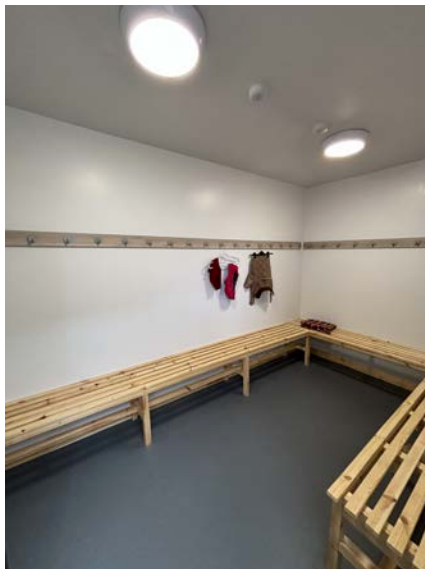
- There is a drying room adjacent to the toilet block, which can be accessed via the pathway around the toilet block

- The door opens to 800mm wide, over a 40mm threshold and opens inwards
- There is 1200mm x 2200mm clear space within the room
- There is a 500mm high bench that runs around the whole room
- There are hooks along the whole room at 1600mm high

Defibrillator Room – Adjacent to Reception

- Access via the tarmaced area around reception
- There is a 120mm step into the door externally, and a 45mm step internally
- The door is 750mm wide
- There is only 700mm x 700mm space within the room



Service Points

- There are Service Points around the site, please check the site map for details
- All of the service points are on raised concrete settings, with level access from adjacent roadways
- The water taps are at a maximum of 780mm high, with cross head taps
- Chemical Emptying Points can be found here too, with ledges at 540mm and taps at 1130mm high



Motorhome Service Point

- There is one Motorhome Service Point on site, located close to the toilet block
- There are 1140mm high taps mounted on a 120mm high curb



Recycling & Waste Area

- This site has a waste and recycling area, located at the entrance of the site. If you have any concerns or questions please discuss with the site team during your stay.

- A range of leaflets for local attractions are available in the reception
- Please ask at reception if you have difficulty reading third party leaflets and staff will be happy to read these to you upon request

Customer Care & Support

Booking Procedures

- If you have any specific requirements for your stay please contact the site directly and they will be happy to discuss your requirements and reserve you the most suitable pitch wherever possible.

Evacuation

- There is an assembly point opposite reception in the event of an emergency
- Please ask at reception for more details

- All on site staff have received disability awareness and etiquette training.

Public Transport

- There is a bus service a ten minute walk from site, with buses that run to Fort William, Ballachulish, Kinlochleven and Oban
