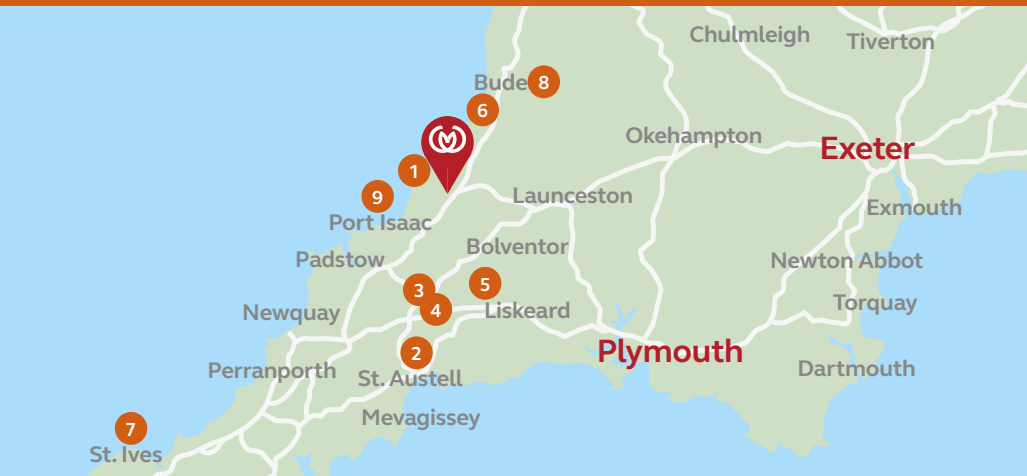

Things to do

- 1 Boscastle**
A picturesque, historic fishing village renowned for its dramatic steep-sided valley, medieval harbour and rugged coastline. It features quaint stone cottages, unique attractions and popular coastal walking paths.
- 2 The Eden Project**
Featuring massive Biomes that house the world's largest indoor rainforest it operates as a 'living theatre' of plants, promoting sustainability, environmental education and regeneration.
- 3 Bodmin and Wenford Steam Railway**
A heritage steam railway providing a nostalgic 1950s-style travel experience through scenic countryside.
- 4 Lanhydrock House and Garden**
A high-Victorian country estate giving a glimpse into both luxurious 'upstairs' family life and 'below stairs' service, in extensive grounds.

- 5 Carnglaze Caverns**
Take a tour through 3 underground caverns of cathedral proportions and see the famous subterranean crystal-clear lake.
- 6 Surfing**
Widemouth Bay is a premier and consistent surf spot and body boarding beach – often recognised as one of the UK's top 10 beaches.
- 7 St. Ives**
A beautiful seaside town adorned by golden beaches, pretty cobbled streets, luscious flora and a thriving art scene.
- 8 Bude**
Voted as the UK's Best Coastal Resort, this laid-back and charming town is a prime destination for surfing, coastal walking and relaxing in its own sunny micro-climate.
- 9 Port Isaac**
Set amidst rolling hilltops and a rugged coast, this active harbour town offers top-tier seafood.

Walk

There are many walks in the local area, and the Bodmin Moor Area National Landscape is close as well as the South West Coastal Path.

Cycle

The Camel Trail, an 18 mile mainly level route through beautiful Cornish countryside, is 6 miles away.

The nearest National Cycle Network route is 3: Bristol to Lands End.
