3 Level Access

 The site is relatively level throughout, however there are cobblestones at the entrance of the site

T Step only Access

The site does not have any step only access, but it is worth noting that most doors
have a small lip at the entrance

Arrival and Reception

Approach Route

- Access onto the site is via a long single track road, it is clearly signposted there should be no new arrivals prior to 1pm
- The reception building is on the right hand side when you enter the site
- There are no access barriers on the site
- The ground in this area is cobbled and uneven

Parking

- A new arrival bay is set within a few metres of the Reception building, however there are cobblestones in this area which may be difficult to navigate with walking aids or a wheelchair
- There is space for 7 cars to park opposite Reception, however there are no marked bays or disabled bays. The closest spot is 15 metres from reception
- There are no late night arrival bays

Entrance into Reception

- There is a paved pathway around the reception
- The entrance door is 950mm wide with a 25mm rollover strip
- The entrance door is not power assisted, and opens inwards
- A call bell is available to summon assistance, this is 1050mm above ground level





Reception

- The reception space is 2800 x 2400mm
- The reception desk is set 900mm above the floor without a lowered section
- The desk is not fitted with a hearing loop
- There are some items available for sale at 750mm high

Getting around the Site

• The site is generally set relatively level throughout



- Pedestrians share vehicles routes which are well maintained tarmac around the main site, but do incorporate speed bumps
- The entrance of the site is cobblestone
- The areas around the facilities are well paved and level, with dropped kerbs for access

Pitches

- There are 120 pitches on site, all of which are hardstanding
- Roll out mats are not provided
- There are no designated accessible pitches, however pitches are allocated according to your needs or preference, so please contact us in advance to discuss your requirements.
- There are 11 standard and 5 super pitches that are allocated for people with accessibility needs when requested. These are close to reception or the toilet block
- Super pitches are level and paved with smooth concrete setts and have fully serviced facilities

Toilets and Changing Facilities

Accessible Toilets and Bathing Facilities – Toilet Block

- A combined Accessible Toilet and Shower cubicle is located in the Toilet Block which is set in the middle of the site
- There is level access to the Accessible Toilet and Shower cubicle
- The door is 820mm wide and opens outwards, over a level threshold
- The cubicle door is secured by RADAR key. A key can be borrowed from Reception
- The cubicle's overall dimensions are 1950mm x 3150mm
- The WC pan is right hand transfer.
- There is a drop down shower seat fitted
- The toilet seat is 480mm above the floor level
- The clear space to the side of the toilet is 1300mm wide
- The cubicle is fitted with a pull cord alarm, which is tested frequently
- The shower seat and WC Pan are fitted with grab rails to assist transfer



- Shower controls are 1000mm high
- The shower head is fitted on a sliding rail, which is a minimum of 1350mm above floor level
- The basin taps and shower controls are fitted with levers






Standard Toilets and Washrooms

- There is one toilet and shower block in the middle of the site
- There is a gently sloping gradient to the entrance of the Male and Female toilets
- The doors to the male and female areas are 750mm wide with a 40mm threshold
- The female area has 8 WC cubicles, 10 Shower cubicles and 6 Privacy Washbasin cubicles
- The male area has 5 WC cubicles, 5 Urinals including one lower urinal, 10
 Shower cubicles 7 Privacy Washbasin cubicles
- There are modified WC, Wash Basin and Shower cubicles with grab rails to assist movement in each male and female areas in each toilet block
- Taps in each block incorporate lever controls
- There are also two individual WCs which are accessed directly from the footpath,
 which are used when the main facilities are closed for cleaning.





Baby and Toddler Room

- The Baby and Toddler Room is on the right hand side of the toilet block with level access
- The door is 850mm, opens outwards over a rollover threshold
- There is a standard key to access, with the lock at 1200mm high
- The room's dimensions are 2200mm x 1800mm but narrows to 1150mm wide in front of the bath
- There is a half sized bathtub and twist type taps
- There is a lowered WC at 330mm
- There is a fold down nappy table at 1100mm
- The basin has lever taps







Other Facilities

Dishwashing – Toilet Block - Internal

- There is access from the pathway around the toilet block
- The door is 825mm wide and outwards opening with a rollover threshold

- The rooms has 850mm x 3000mm clear space in front of the sinks
- There are 3 sinks at 850mm high with 650mm kneespace
- Lever taps available





Dishwashing – Toilet Block - External

- There is level access from the path surrounding the toilet block
- There is no door to access
- The sinks are in an 1800mm wide alcove with 2000mm clear space behind
- There are 2 sinks at 850mm high with no kneespace
- Lever taps available





Laundry - Toilet Block

- There is access to the laundry room from the pathway surrounding the toilet block
- The door is 850mm wide with a rollover threshold and opens inwards
- The room's dimensions are 3800mm x 1800mm but narrows to 1200mm wide between the sinks and machines
- There are two front loading washing machines with coin slots and controls at 1040mm
- There are two front loading tumble dryers, however they are stacked on top of each other the highest opening at 1650mm
- There are 3 sinks at 850mm with 600mm kneespace below
- Lever taps fitted



Information Room – Adjacent to Reception

- Access via a dropped kerb further down the path to reception
- The door is 700mm with a 25mm threshold and opens outwards
- The room's dimensions are 1200mm x 1200mm
- Information is displayed on a desk at 900mm high and in a display cabinet between 500mm and 1200mm high







Dog Walk

- There is a dog area to the east of the site
- There is access via a large double gate
- There is a relatively level tarmac path throughout the dog walk





Access to Chatsworth House

- There is access to the main house and grounds via a gate adjacent to the dog walk
- There is a smooth ramp leading to the gate
- The gate opens to 850mm wide, with a key hole at 1150mm high
- On the other side of the gate, there is approximately 10 metres of fairly level grass to the tarmac path leading to the house and the gardens



Service Points



- There are Service Points at intervals around the site, please check the site map for details
- There is level access to the service points from the adjacent roadways
- The paths around the Service Points can be as narrow as 850mm wide
- The water taps are at a maximum of 1200mm high, with cross head taps
- Chemical Emptying Points can be found here too, with ledges at 600mm high
- Chemical Emptying Point taps are 1200mm high



Motorhome Service Point

- There is one Motorhome Service Point on site, located close to the toilet block
- The taps are a maximum of 1250mm high
