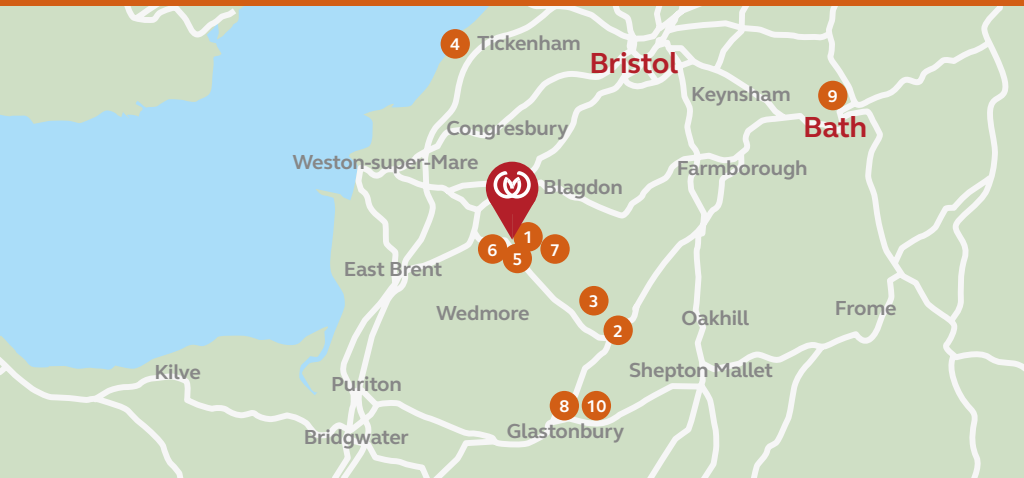

## Things to do

### 1 Cheddar Gorge and Caves

The UK's largest limestone gorge, 400 feet deep stretching for 3 miles. Famous for its crags, clifftop views, underground show caves and as the natural origin of Cheddar cheese.

### 2 Wells

Named after local springs and England's smallest city renowned for its rich medieval heritage, stunning Gothic cathedral and the moated Bishop's Palace.

### 3 Wookey Hole Caves

A magical land of caves, legends and adventures. Explorers of all ages can enjoy an experience millions of years in the making.

### 4 Clevedon Pier

The only fully intact, beautifully restored Grade I listed pier in the UK, widely regarded for its ironwork, operating as a vibrant community hub.

### 5 Cheddar Crazy Golf

Located in the heart of the Gorge, this challenging 18 hole miniature course is surrounded by stunning views. Fun for people of all ages!

### 6 Caveclimb

Adventure provider offering bespoke, instructor-led underground and outdoor experiences in caving, climbing and abseiling, tailored to all ages and abilities.

### 7 Mendip Hills

A National Landscape, the stunning landscape of steep slopes, spectacular gorges and rocky outcrops – a walkers paradise.

### 8 Glastonbury Abbey

A spectacular and spiritual site renowned for medieval ruins, tranquil parkland, early Christian history and the burial place of King Arthur.

### 9 Bath

Known for its natural hot springs and honey-coloured Georgian architecture, the city combines contemporary culture with rich history, overflowing with popular attractions.

### 10 Glastonbury

Steeped in the legends of King Arthur and the Holy Grail, the mystical Tor and the beautiful Abbey ruins make a great day out.

## Walk

To walk into Cheddar, turn left at the site entrance and walk to the railway arch. Go up the steps, turn left at the top and the footpath leads into Cheddar. There is no pavement on the main road.

## Cycle

The Strawberry Line, a 10 mile, traffic-free cycle route is easily accessible directly from the site and offers beautiful views over the Somerset Levels.

The Quantock Hills is great for mountain biking with its technical descents, challenging climbs and outstanding views.

Site access restrictions:

- ✓ Barrier card issued on arrival

### Accessing the facilities

Facility access restrictions:

- ✓ Key operated door lock on the accessible room

### Connectivity

- ✓ Mobile phone signal – fair. Mobile phone signal may vary depending on network provider
- ✓ TV reception – poor. TV booster system available on bollard. 25 metre aerial coaxial cable may be required
- ✓ Club Wi-Fi. Premium wifi – *charges apply*. Free wifi to the pitch

- ✓ Machines are token operated only. Tokens are available from reception at £1.25 each. All washing machine cycles are £5, pre-wash is £1.25 and a 15 minute tumble dryer cycle is £1.25
