- 1 Sudeley Castle**
The burial place of Katherine Parr, the last of Henry VIII's six wives. The grounds have an adventure playground and assault course.
- 2 Gloucester Cathedral**
Discover the cathedral's secrets from Edward II's Tomb to the Whispering Gallery.
- 3 Mechanical Music Museum**
A living museum of the extraordinary variety of self-playing musical instruments.
- 4 Nature In Art**
Museum and art gallery dedicated to art inspired by nature. It has a programme of exhibitions, Sculpture Garden, artist in residence, children's activity days and adult art courses.
- 5 Gloucester Ski and Snowboard Centre**
Year round snowsport experience with a 230m main slope, recreational and nursery slopes.
- 6 Head 4 Heights Ltd**
Outdoor aerial adventure park offering a range of activities for children and families.
- 7 Combat Splat Archery and Air Rifle Ranges**
Individual tuition in sheltered shooting huts.
- 8 Cheltenham**
The cultural capital of the Cotswolds, this stylish city is renowned for its great shopping, theatre and festivals, making it a brilliant year-round destination.
- 9 Gloucester**
Steeped in over 2,000 years of history, this city boasts a wealth of beautiful architecture and fascinating museums, in addition to a plentiful supply of attractions, including its dramatic docks and cathedral.

Walk

A good walking route near the campsite is the circular walk around the outside of the racecourse, but please don't walk on the racecourse itself.

There's a circular walk around Cheltenham which is around 25-minutes away on foot and the Cleeve Hill and Cotswold Way are nearby.

Cycle

Pittville Park is a good place for cycling. The nearest National Cycle Network route to this site is route number 41, Severn Bridge to Stratford. OS ref SO953235.

Accessing the site/facilities

Access codes/keys are issued at check-in.

Once you've pitched up, please go to reception and collect your Racecourse Security Pass. Please display this in your vehicle at all times and show this at the Racecourse Security Gate when returning to the campsite. Without this pass, security will not allow campsite access before 1pm and after 8pm.

Please return the security pass to the reception/letter box before you plan to depart the campsite.

The 'drive-over' motorhome service and freshwater point is located near the ladies facilities. We ask motorhomes not to stop at the other service points on the site to avoid blocking the access routes.

Useful information

Although there's no children's play area on site, Pittville Park Children's Play area is 0.7 mile/18-minute walk from the campsite. Pittville Park is split into two sides. The east side has a huge play area with a kiosk, Pittville Pump Room, aviaries, lake, toilets, Central Cross Café, Sundae Shack and lots of green space which host events throughout the year. The west side has a boating lake and boathouse, pitch and putt golf course, tennis courts, natural play equipment and a skateboarding/BMX area.

Cheltenham Town Centre is about a 30-minute walk from the campsite.
