At a Glance

3 Level Access

The site is relatively level throughout but does slope upwards from Toilet Block 1 to
 Toilet Block 2, with level access to most areas

Step only Access

 The reception does have a 65mm threshold which may be difficult to manoeuvre over

There is a combined accessible toilet and shower cubicle in the toilet block

Arrival and Reception

Approach Route

- Access onto the site is via a long tarmac road, with clear signs to the site
- The reception building is on the left hand side when you enter the site
- The gate from the road is left open at all times but access into the site is controlled via a vehicle barrier controlled by card access.
- The ground is level in this area with hard surfaced paths linking facilities.

Parking

- There are 2 new arrival lanes outside of reception
- There is a level grassed area within 35 metres of reception for car parking at the main entrance of the site. There are no designated accessible bays.
- There is 2 Late Night Arrival Bays with electric hook ups

Entrance into Reception


- There is a dropped kerb leading to a short ramp with a single handrail, to the reception building
- There is also a stepped approach with a single handrail to the reception building
- The Entrance Door is 800mm with a 65mm threshold, which could be difficult for those in wheelchairs to maneuvre
- The entrance door is not power assisted, and opens inwards
- A call bell is available to summon assistance, this is 1200mm above ground level





Reception

- There is approximately 2500mm x 2800mm turning space, clear of the desk and furniture
- The reception desk is set 900mm high, with no lowered counter or kneespace
- The desk is not fitted with a hearing loop
- There are some items available for sale between 100mm and 1800mm high







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Getting around the Site

- The site is generally set relatively level throughout, but slopes upwards from Toilet Block 1 to Toilet Block 2 and the gradient in front of Toilet Block 2 can be steep
- Pedestrians share vehicles routes which are well maintained tarmac, but do incorporate speed bumps

Pitches

- There are 211 pitches on site, 133 of which are hardstanding
- Roll out mats are not provided
- There are no designated accessible pitches, however pitches are allocated according to your needs or preference, so please contact us in advance to discuss your requirements.
- There are 10 gravel pitches on a level section in front of Toilet Block 1 that are recommended for those with accessibility needs
- There are also 7 grass pitches available around the perimeter of Toilet Block 2,
 which may be appropriate for those with accessibility requirements

Toilets and Changing Facilities

Accessible Toilets and Bathing Facilities - Toilet Block 1

- A combined Accessible Toilet and Shower cubicle is located in Toilet Block 1 which is in the middle of the site
- The toilet block is accessed via a raised paved area with dropped kerbs, or it can be accessed via a ramp or 2 steps.
- The door is 850mm wide, over a level threshold and opens inwards
- The cubicle door is secured by RADAR key. A key can be borrowed from Reception
- The cubicle's overall dimensions are 2300mm x 3000mm
- The WC pan is right hand transfer.
- The shower seat is left hand transfer
- The toilet seat is 480mm, and the shower seat is 500mm above the floor level
- The clear space to the side of the toilet is 1500mm wide
- The cubicle is fitted with a pull cord alarm, which is tested frequently
- The shower seat and WC Pan are fitted with grab rails to assist transfer



- Shower controls are 1000mm high
- The shower head is fitted on a sliding rail, which is a minimum of 1350mm above floor level
- The basin taps and shower controls are fitted with levers



Accessible Toilets and Bathing Facilities – Toilet Block 2

- A combined Accessible Toilet and Shower cubicle is located in Toilet Block 2
 which is towards the west of the site
- The toilet block is accessed via a raised paved area with dropped kerbs, or it can be accessed via a ramp or a step.
- There is an internal lobby to access the Accessible Toilet. The external door opens to 850mm wide over a level threshold, and opens outwards
- The door to the accessible toilet is 850mm wide, over a level threshold and opens inwards
- The cubicle door is secured by RADAR key. A key can be borrowed from Reception
- The cubicle's overall dimensions are 2000mm x 2300mm
- The WC pan is left hand transfer.
- The shower seat is left hand transfer
- The toilet seat is 480mm, and the shower seat is 500mm above the floor level

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The clear space to the side of the toilet is 1500mm wide



- The cubicle is fitted with a pull cord alarm, which is tested frequently
- The shower seat and WC Pan are fitted with grab rails to assist transfer
- Shower controls are 900mm high
- The shower head is fitted on a sliding rail, which is a minimum of 1200mm above floor level
- The basin taps and shower controls are fitted with levers



Standard Toilets and Washrooms

- There are two toilet blocks on site, Toilet Block 1 is towards the middle of the site and Toilet Block 2 is towards the west of the site
- Parking is available next to both of the Toilet Blocks for 2 vehicles
- Entrance doors to Toilet Block 1 are accessed via the paved area externally.
- There is an internal lobby to Toilet Block 2, which leads to the male and female areas, the accessible toilet and shower and the baby and toddler room.
- The external door to the lobby in Toilet Block 2 opens to 850mm wide
- The female area in Toilet Block 1 has 10 WC cubicles, 10 Shower cubicles and 6
 Privacy Washbasin cubicles

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 The male area in Toilet Block 1 has 6 Urinals, including 1 lower Urinal, 8 WC cubicles, 10 Shower cubicles and 6 Privacy Washbasin cubicles



- The female area in Toilet Block 2 has 8 WC cubicles, 5 Shower cubicles and 5
 Privacy Washbasin cubicles
- The male area in Toilet Block 2 has 4 Urinals, 4 WC cubicles, 5 Shower cubicles and 6 Privacy Washbasin cubicles
- In both of the male and female areas there is a modified WC cubicle, shower cubicle and privacy washbasin cubicle, with grab rails to assist with mobility
- Taps in each block incorporate lever controls

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Baby and Toddler Room - Toilet Block 1



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- There is a Baby and Toddler Room in Toilet Block 1
- The door is 850mm wide over a level threshold and opens inwards
- There is a keypad lock at 1650mm high
- The rooms' dimensions are 2000mm x 2400mm
- There are lowered WC at 330mm
- There is a half sized bathtub, with a shower above with twist turn taps
- There is a drop down changing unit at 800mm high
- The basin has lever taps to it



Baby and Toddler Room - Toilet Block 2

- There is a Baby and Toddler Room in Toilet Block 2, which is accessed via the internal lobby
- The door is 850mm wide over a level threshold and opens inwards
- There is a 1700mm high keypad lock to enter
- There is 1500mm x 2500mm circulation space, and a further 700mm x 650mm
 where the toilet is, which can be too narrow
- There are lowered WC at 330mm
- There is a half sized bathtub, with a shower above with twist turn taps
- There is a drop down changing unit at 900mm high
- The basin has lever taps to it

Other Facilities

Dishwashing - Toilet Block 1

- Level approach via paved area, the dishwashing area is at the rear of the block
- The door is 850mm wide over a level threshold, and opens inwards
- The room's dimensions are 3000mm x 2100mm
- There are 5 sinks in a counter at 900mm high, with only 600mm kneespace
- Lever taps available





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Dishwashing - Toilet Block 2

- Level approach via paved area,
- The dishwashing area is under a recessed canopy at the front of the building
- There is 1500mm space in front of the sinks
- There are 3 sinks in a counter at 880mm high, with only 570mm kneespace
- Lever taps available



Laundry – Toilet Block 1

- Level access via a covered paved area
- The door is 850mm wide over a level threshold and opens inwards
- There is 1500mm space in front of the sinks and machines
- There are 2 front loading washing machines and 2 front loading tumble dryers,
 with controls at 1200mm high
- One of the tumble dryers is stacked on top of the other, with the top door being 1600mm high
- There are 3 sinks in a counter at 900mm high with only 600mm kneespace
- Lever taps fitted

Laundry - Toilet Block 2

- Level access at the front of the block, accessed externally
- The door is 850mm wide with a level threshold and opens inwards
- There is 2200mm x 1900mm space in front of the sinks and machines
- There is one front loading washing machine and one front loading tumble dryers,
 with controls at 1200mm high
- There are 2 sinks in a counter at 850mm high with 570mm kneespace
- Lever taps fitted







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Information Room – Opposite Reception

- The information room is in a small hut opposite the reception building
- There is a dropped kerb leading to the information room
- The door opens to 800mm wide, with a level threshold and opens inwards
- The information room's dimensions are 2200mm x 1900mm
- Information is displayed on a shelf at 1000mm high





Play Area

- There is a play area to the middle of the site
- There is a 1200mm wide, bark surfaced path to access the play area
- There is a 1100mm wide timber gate
- The play area has a rubberised surface





Dog Walking and Playing Field Area

- There is a dog walk and playing field to the west of the site
- These are accessed over uneven grass
- There are separate gates to the dog walking field and the playing field
- There is a paved path that extends from the gate one third of the way to the road



Service Points

 There are Service Points at intervals around the site, please check the site map for details

- All of the service points are on concrete settings
- The paths around the Service Points can be as narrow as 700mm wide



- The water taps are at a maximum of 900mm high, with cross head taps
- Chemical Waste Points can be found here too



Motorhome Waste Point

- There are three Motorhome Waste Point on site, there is one adjacent to each toilet block and one close to the exit of the site
- The Motorhome Waste Points are drive over points
- The taps are a maximum of 1250mm high
