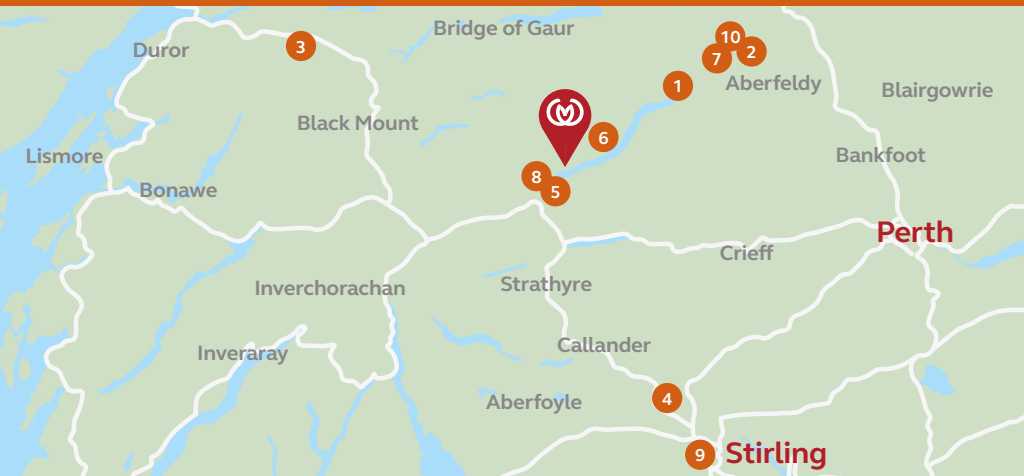


Clachan Killin Club Campsite

Things to do

- 1 Scottish Crannog Centre**
An immersive, award-winning open-air museum and guided experience featuring a reconstructed Iron Age loch-dwelling.
- 2 Dewar's Aberfeldy Distillery**
An interactive visitor centre dedicated to the history, blending and production of Dewar's Scotch Whisky at the Aberfeldy Distillery.
- 3 Glencoe Mountain Resort**
Stunning views towards the Buachaille Etive Mòr and Rannoch Moor. The centre offers mountain biking, hill-walking, climbing, chairlift rides and a tubing slope.
- 4 Blair Drummond Safari Park**
Come face-to-face with incredible animals from around the world, brave the dinosaur forest or watch the spectacular bird of prey display.
- 5 Killin Golf Club**
Described as the most beautiful in Scotland, Killin is a challenging yet spectacular 9 hole course with natural hazards. Guests can borrow clubs for free from the club house.

- 6 Fishing**
Fishing lochs are easily accessible with permits available from the local newsagent. Loch Tay Fish 'N' Trips offer boat hire, guided trips or full ghillie fishing.
- 7 Castle Menzies**
A spectacular 16th Century Scottish Castle, serving as the historic seat of the Clan of Menzies.
- 8 Ben Lawers National Nature Reserve**
A premier conservation site known for its arctic-alpine flora and surrounding Munros mountains, including the highest, Ben Lawers.
- 9 Stirling**
The Gateway to the Highlands, visit Stirling Castle, The National Wallace Monument and The Battle of Bannockburn Experience in this vibrant and scenic City.
- 10 Highland Safaris**
Immersive Highland experiences via Landrover safaris, a Red Deer Centre for close encounters and boat safaris.

Walk

There are many varied walks nearby. A good route is towards Loch Tay, joining the old railway line through Killin. Scotland's towering Munros mountains offer stunning views and wonderful challenge for those with hill walking experience.

Cycle

The nearest National Cycle Network route to site is 7: Glasgow to Pitlochry (the Lochs and Glens route north). Cycle up Glen Lochay and you may see a Golden Eagle. Or try the woodland trails starting at the Old Station.
