Cistercian Abbey ruins, lake, craft centre, gardens and woodland.

The park is a great place to explore with signposted wide, flat paths, wildlife to discover and great views.

You can enjoy cycling from the site into the park - there are over 20 miles of open trails and bicycle lock up on site.

Visitor's top tips

|| Visit Wellbeck Abbey, complete with a museum, farm shop and garden centre.

Pack a portable bird feeder to see nuthatch, chaffinch, goldfinch and even woodpeckers on site.

The volunteer-led walks from the Discovery Centre at Clumber Park are very interesting.

Hardwick Village is not too far a walk, and has a coffee/refreshments van as well as a picturesque lake with outdoor seating.

A must is a walk along lime tree avenue – the scent is just wonderful.

Clumber Park has a shop, cafe and bike hire facilities, and there are lots of cycle routes in the park.

There's a Park Run at 9am on Saturday mornings, setting off from the Clumber Park Visitor Centre.

Wollaton Hall is a 45-minute drive from site. There's a great Natural History Museum which the kids loved!

Yorkshire Wildlife Park is only a short drive away and makes a lovely day out. In August, they have a fantastic concert and firework display every Saturday. **||**
