Things to do

- 1 Port Lympne Safari Park**
Authentic safari truck experience through 600 acre wildlife sanctuary housing over 900 rare and endangered animals, including giraffes, rhinos and big cats, roaming in expansive, naturalistic habitats.
- 2 Dover Castle**
A medieval fortress perched on the White Cliffs to guard the shortest sea crossing, earning it the name 'Key to England'. Enter the Secret Wartime Tunnels and climb the Great Tower.
- 3 Romney, Hythe and Dymchurch Railway**
A heritage light railway from Hythe to Dungeness, through the Romney Marsh. Kent's mainline in miniature, the 15-inch gauge track runs third-size steam and diesel locomotives.
- 4 Rare Breeds Centre**
A working 100 acre farm, home to many rare and native breeds of farm livestock. Welcoming visitors of all ages for learning and skills training.

- 5 Camber Sands**
A stunning 5 mile stretch of tranquil coastline, famous for soft golden sand and the only dynamic sand dune system in the UK.
- 6 Action Watersports**
Water-skiing, wakeboarding, jet skiing, flyboarding and paddleboarding on a sheltered lake with separate Aqua Park.
- 7 Folkestone**
A vibrant, creative coastal town recognised for its artistic scene, historic harbour sunny sandy beaches and rapid regeneration.
- 8 Rye**
A charming hilltop town with a jumbled network of steep cobbled lanes and unique historic buildings.
- 9 Dover**
A historic coastal town and major ferry port renowned for its iconic, White Cliffs. Known as the 'Gateway to England' due to its proximity to France, it serves as a critical transportation hub.

Walk

Good walking routes near the site include footpaths around Romney Marsh and the Royal Military Canal – near Army Ranges so not suitable for all dogs.

Cycle

There are cycle routes adjacent to the site and around Romney Marsh. The nearest National Cycle Network route to site is 2: Dover to Newhaven.
