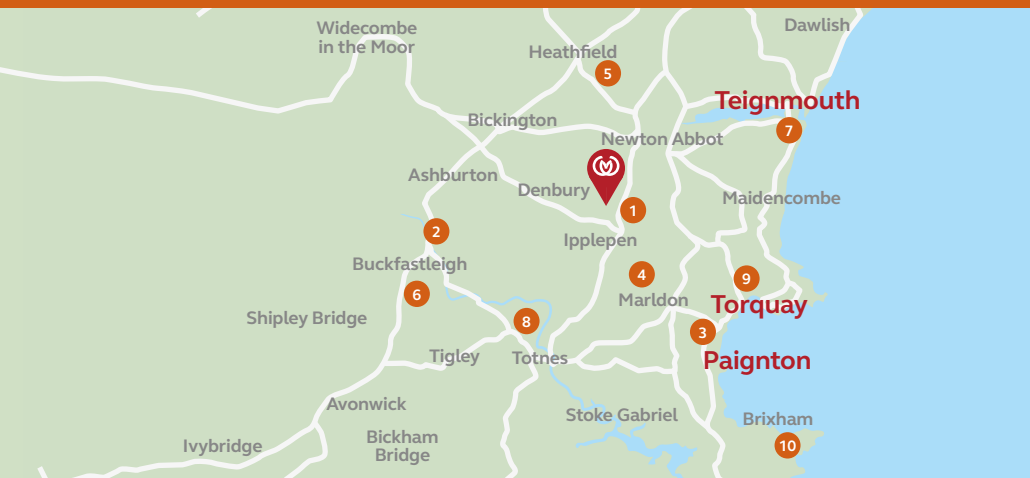

Things to do

1 Go Falconry

Hands-on bird of prey experiences, including handling and flying to the glove, led by a team of falconers with a magnificent collection of hawks, owls and falcons.

2 South Devon Railway

This 7 mile heritage steam railway runs the valley of the River Dart between Buckfastleigh and Totnes, operating vintage trains and carriages for a nostalgic travel experience.

3 Paignton Zoo

One of England's largest zoos with over 2,000 animals and 80 acres of beautiful botanical gardens, in immersive habitat-themed areas.

4 Compton Castle

A rare 14th Century fortified Manor House featuring high curtain walls, towers and a portcullis gateway – a haven of tranquillity.

5 Stover Country Park

A Site of Special Scientific Interest and a local nature reserve offering a peaceful, accessible, year-round birdwatching environment.

6 Pennywell Farm

An award-winning, large activity farm offering hands-on animal experiences and hourly activities.

7 Shaldon Wildlife Trust

A small, conservation-focused zoo dedicated to preserving rare and endangered primates such as golden lion tamarins and marmosets.

8 Boat trips on the River Dart

Short Dart cruises or longer circular scenic loops to see beautiful landscapes, wildlife and historic sites.

9 Torquay

Part of the UNESCO-listed English Riviera, due to its mild climate, sandy beaches, palm trees and vibrant harbour.

10 Brixham

Also forming part of the English Riviera, this charming and colourful town with a busy harbour plays a major role in today's English fishing industry.

Walk

The largest and wildest area of open country in Southern England, with miles of footpaths and beautiful scenery to explore.

Cycle

The nearest National Cycle Network route to site is 2: Exeter to Plymouth.
