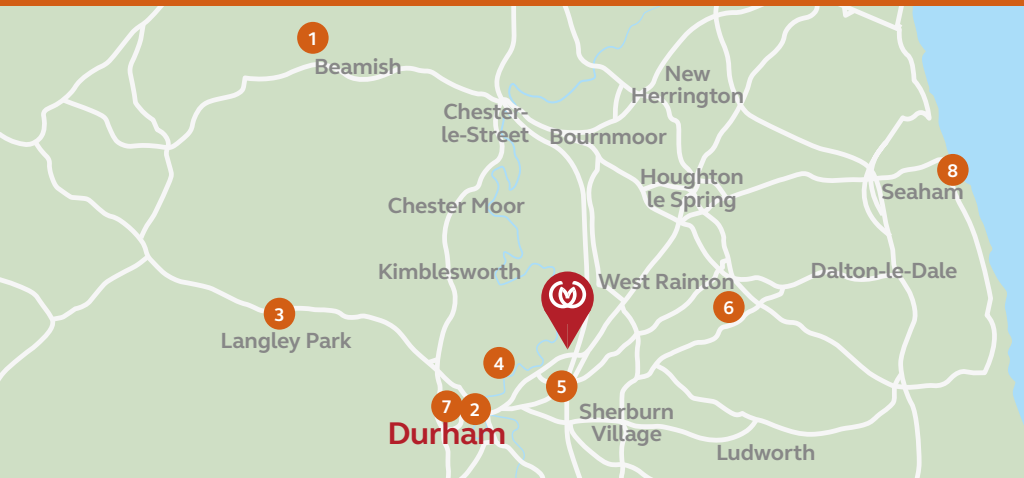

Things to do

1 Beamish Museum

An open-air museum that brings North East English history to life, showcasing life from the 1820-1950s with reconstructed towns, costumed interpreters, working transport, a drift mine and farms.

2 Durham Castle and Cathedral

A UNESCO World Heritage Site, celebrated for Norman architecture and Romanesque design. Housing relics of St. Cuthbert and Bede and serving as a Durham University College.

3 Diggerland

A unique adventure theme park where children and adults can drive, ride and operate real construction machinery, including JCBs, excavators and dumpers.

4 Jump This – Parachute

An adrenaline filled skydiving experience. Jump out from 15,000 feet, strapped to an instructor, reaching speeds of ~125mph before a 6 minute canopy ride with views of the Durham coast.

5 Karting Nation

A 200 metre indoor go-karting circuit featuring tight bends and straights designed to test skill levels. For all age racers, complete with a spectator gallery.

6 Adventure Valley

The North East's largest family adventure park, with outdoor activities and indoor play, including a working farmyard, pony grooming and themed play zones.

7 Oriental Museum

The only museum solely dedicated to the art and archaeology of North Africa and Asia. Housing over 23,500 artifacts, including ancient Egyptian, Chinese and Islamic treasures.

8 Seaham

A vibrant, harbour town known for dramatic limestone cliffs, sandy beaches and an industrial heritage. Once a coal port, it has transformed into a popular tourist destination famous for sea glass collecting.

Walk

The Durham Heritage Coast walk is an 11 mile route from Seaham to Crimdon along stunning cliff-top scenery following the England Coast Path National Trail.

Cycle

The nearest National Cycle Network route is 14: Darlington in County Durham, north-east to Hartlepool, then north-west through Durham to Consett.

Route 70 also passes near the site, this long-distance coast-to-coast cycle route links Walney Island by Barrow-In-Furness to Sunderland.
