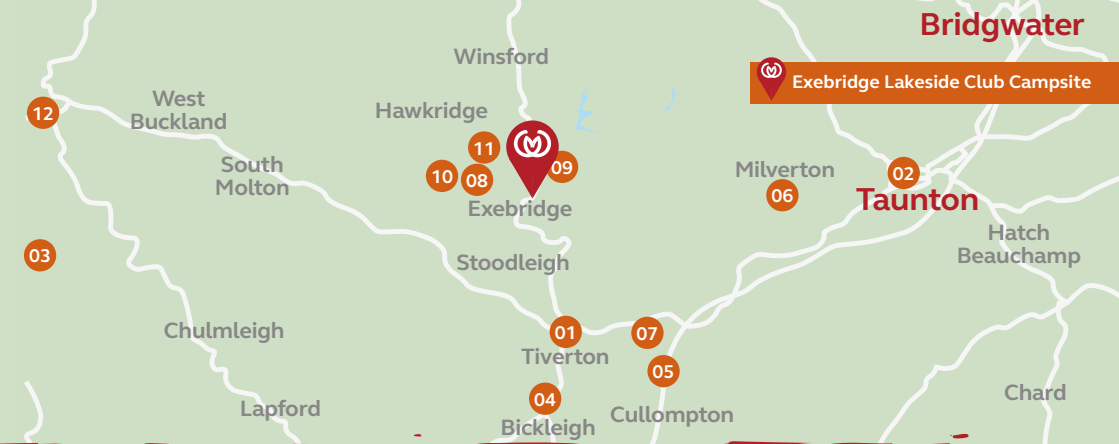

1 Tiverton Castle

With views over the River Exe, 900 years of history and plenty of exhibitions and displays it's great fun for families.

9 National Cycle Network

The nearest National Cycle Network route to this site is route number 3, Taunton to Hatherleigh.

10 Exmoor National Park

There are routes available around Exmoor for all abilities, whether you'd like to enjoy the peaceful network of country lanes, or climb the challenging 1705ft to the highest point at Dunkery.

8 Local routes

Beautiful walks of various lengths can be followed around the forest plus fishing in the lakes – permits can be purchased from the site.



Explore

11 Dulverton

A beautiful, historic market town set on the River Barle, home to the oldest medieval bridge on Exmoor, with lots of lovely boutique shops and local eateries.

12 Barnstaple

Known as the social heart of North Devon, this delightful town offers a plethora of things to do, from theatre and museums to great shopping, peaceful parks and cafés.



Visitor's top tips

|| Try the 3.5 mile walk to Dulverton where you'll find great pubs and tearooms. (You can always get the bus back!)

Excellent coarse fishing is available next to the site with permits available from reception and Wimbleball Lake is only a few miles away.

The views from Porlock Hill are incredible!

The local pub, The Anchor, is a 5 minute walk away.

Cheddar Gorge & Village makes a wonderful day out, around an hour away.

Visit the National Trust's Knightshayes Court, Dunkery Beacon & Dunster Castle.

The Tarr Steps is a gorgeous spot for dog walks.

Woods Bar & Restaurant is great lunch or dinner in Dulverton.

Head to Lynmouth for the day to explore it's phenomenal setting, or a little further to Minehead or Ilfracombe.

Catch a glimpse of life over 800 years ago at Cleeve Abbey.

Quince Honey Farm is a lovely day out for the family.

Visit Exeter for its cathedral, antique shops and restaurants on the quay. **||**
