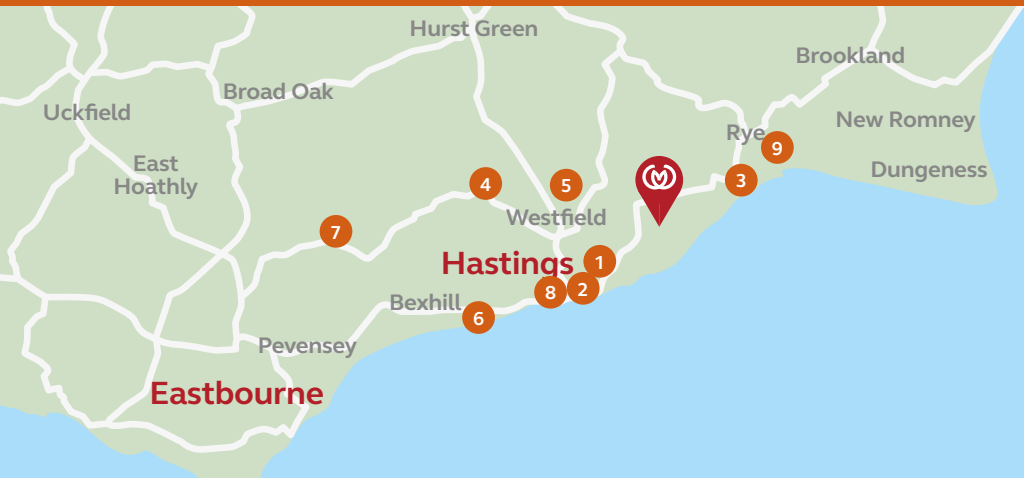

Things to do

1 St Clements Caves

A 14,000 BC Ice Age, partly man-made sandstone cavern system, used in the 17th/18th Century to smuggle contraband and now the Smugglers Adventure tourist attraction.

2 Hastings Castle

A historic, largely ruined motte-and-bailey fortress of scattered stone ruins, a preserved dungeon and an exhibition. Known as the first English castle built by William the Conqueror in 1066.

3 Rye Harbour Nature Reserve

A large coastal sanctuary protecting plants and animals across shingle, saltmarsh and lagoons. With a Discovery Centre, birdwatching hides and walking trails.

4 Battle Abbey

A partially ruined monastery to commemorate the Battle of Hastings. Located on Senlac Hill, the high altar was purposefully placed where King Harold is believed to have died.

5 Carr Taylor Vineyard

A renowned English vineyard known for pioneering traditional method sparkling wines and being a significant producer. Offering tours, tastings, a café and scenic views.

6 Watersports

Bexhill, Camber and Pevensey offer a mix of high-adrenaline kiting, serene paddleboarding and family-friendly sailing, catering to beginners and advanced thrill-seekers.

7 Fishing

Fish for trout in the 6 lakes at Brick Farm Lakes or for mackerel and bass from the harbour arm at Hastings.

8 Hastings

A historic seaside town renowned as the 1066 Norman landing site. It blends a narrow-streeted Old Town with Victorian architecture, a mix of maritime heritage, culture and coastal scenery.

9 Rye

A charming hilltop town with a jumbled network of steep cobbled lanes and unique historic buildings.

Walk

It is a short 10 minute walk through the woods to the local pub, The Two Sawyers.

Hastings Country Park is around 3 miles from the site and has 660 acres of woodland, and 5 kms of dramatic cliffs, coastline and secluded bays.

Cycle

The nearest National Cycle Network route to site is 2: Dover to St Austell – which runs the length of the South Coast.

The route is a mixture of on and off road routes, but there are traffic-free sections between Hastings and Bexhill and from Winchelsea Beach to Rye Harbour.
