

- 1 Nene Valley Railway**
Steam railway from Peterborough to Yarwell, with a discount for members.
- 2 Flag Fen Bronze Age Centre**
Explore a reconstructed Bronze age village and discover our ancestors lives.
- 3 Peterborough Museum**
Housing a large variety of Peterborough's historical and art collections, the museum is located in one of the city's most historical buildings.
- 4 Key Theatre**
Cultural and entertainment venue offering a range of performing arts at its best.
- 5 Nene Outdoors**
Hire kayaks, canoes, row boats and pedaloes, try raft building and orienteering or take courses in sailing, windsurfing and kayaking.




- 6 Sky Diving**
Views over Peterborough from 13'000 feet. Skydiving and Parachute jumps organised by the oldest civilian parachute centre in the UK.
- 7 Balloon Flights**
Take in the views over Peterborough Cathedral and the River Nene.

- 8 Peterborough Cathedral**
Magnificent Norman Architecture and burial place of two queens.
- 9 Barnsdale Gardens**
Britain's largest collection of individually designed gardens.
- 10 Sacrewell Farm**
Perfect for a family day out, kids can explore the beautiful grounds and see the animals.



Walk

- 11 Nene Park**
There are good footpaths in the park, guides are available.
- 12 RSPB Nene Washes**
Walkers can spot swans, birds of prey and harriers amongst others.

Cycle

- 13 Ferry Meadows Country Park**
Cycle hire is available, and there are good family friendly tracks marked as well as more adventurous routes.
- 14 National Cycle Network**
The nearest route is 63, Burton-on-Trent to Wisbech, OS ref TL149975.



Visitor's top tips



Burghley House

Lovely walks around Ferry Meadows Country Park, and great for dogs.

Give the Saturday morning Parkrun around the lakes a try.

The walk into Peterborough takes around an hour. It's a lovely walk but you can catch the steam train back!

We enjoyed playing pitch and putt at the local golf course which was walking distance from site.

Peterborough cathedral is a must see, the city itself has excellent shopping.

Ride the little train at Ferry Meadows park. Book tickets to ride the real train into Peterborough as the station and railway museum are next door to the camp site.

The puddings and cakes at the Mulberry Tree Farm were huge and yummy.

Cycle to the medieval town of Stamford, visiting Burghley House on the way
