The deer park in the Galloway Forest well worth a visit.

Harbour Inn just along from site is very welcoming and serves excellent food.

The Hive cafe in the village is well worth a visit, or the Passing Place pizza van sells woodfired pizzas in the village every Friday.

Lots of great cycling from the site and in Galloway Forest Park.

Highly recommend visits to Logan Botanic, Castle Kennedy and Glenwhan Gardens.

Supermarkets

The closest is the Filling Station in Garlieston which sells limited groceries. A Co-op in Wigtown, Sainsbury's and Aldi in Newton Stewart, Morrison's and Tesco in Stranraer.

Cashpoint

Nearest in Whithorn and Wigtown. Mobile Bank of Scotland in site car park from 12:15pm - 12:35pm every Tuesday.

In Newton-Stewart. Local information centres at Whithorn and Wigtown.

Public transport

There is a bus service approximately every hour 100 yards from site, that goes to Newton-Stewart or the Isle Of Whithorn.
