Things to do

- 1 RSPB Broadwater Warren**
A nature reserve once a commercial conifer plantation, restored to heathland, woodland and wetland managed for species including adders, bumblebees, butterflies and frogs.
- 2 Gatwick Aviation Museum**
A hidden gem for aviation enthusiasts – an impressive collection of British aircraft and engines from post-WWII, Gatwick Airport history and a prime runway viewing area.
- 3 Lingfield Park Racecourse**
The only racecourse in the UK to host racing of all 3 types: flat turf, all-weather and national hunt. Set on a resort with a luxury hotel and an 18 hole golf course.
- 4 Nymans National Trust**
A world-renowned plant-lovers' garden famous for its rare, exotic collections and manor ruin that was ravaged by a fire in 1947.
- 5 Go Ape – Crawley**
An outdoor adventure playground with high-ropes courses, ziplines, Tarzan Swings and forest activities in the woodland treetops.
- 6 Chessington World of Adventures**
A theme park with over 40 rides, a massive zoo and a sealife centre, the resort provides an exciting family-friendly day out for all ages.
- 7 Tulleys Farm**
Internationally celebrated for its enormous seasonal events combining agriculture with themed attractions, festivals and theatre, escape rooms, a farm shop and animal encounters.
- 8 The Bluebell Railway**
A heritage line operating with restored vintage steam locomotives, serving as a living museum, offering nostalgic countryside journeys.
- 9 Bolney Estate Wine**
A pioneer of English winemaking, renowned for its cool-climate character, the estate is celebrated for elegant, fruit-forward wines.
- 10 Wakehurst Place**
A spectacular botanic garden with a magnificent Elizabethan mansion, temperate woodlands and the globally vital Millennium Seed Bank.

Walk

Good walks can be enjoyed in the local parks within 2 miles of the site. The Ashdown Forest, home of Winnie the Pooh is also nearby.

The largest and most popular park in the area, Tilgate Park boasts woods, lakes, play areas, a nature centre, walled gardens and beautiful walks and is just over 4 miles from site.

Cycle

The nearest National Cycle Network route to site is 21, Gatwick to Eastbourne.
