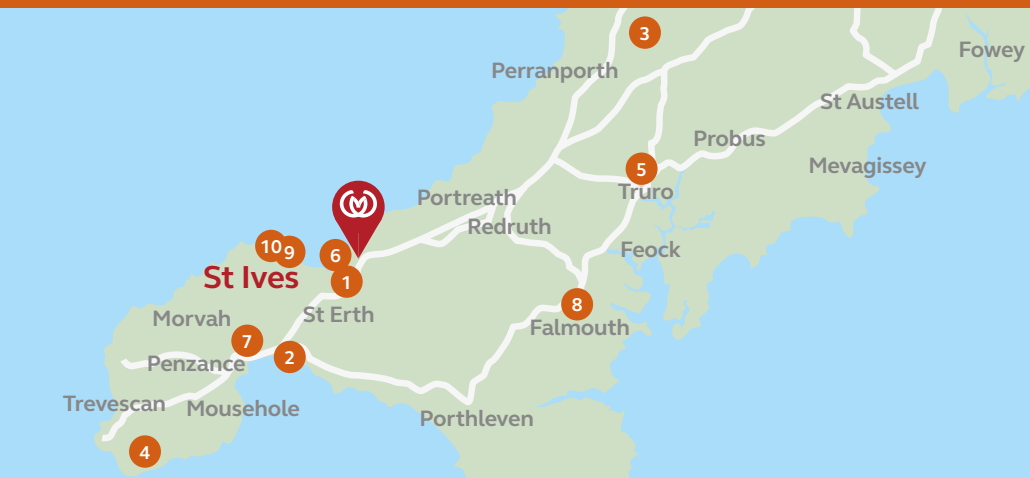

## Things to do

### 1 Paradise Park Wildlife Sanctuary

Award-winning wildlife conservation centre home to birds and animals – including penguins, flamingos, red pandas and otters. Also a large indoor JungleBarn soft play centre.

### 2 St Michael's Mount

A breathtaking small tidal island with its own fairytale castle, sweeping lawns, sloping subtropical gardens and harbour village.

### 3 Lappa Valley Steam Railway

The secret world of play and trains – featuring 3 railways, including the 15-inch gauge steam train journey, set within a scenic, tranquil valley.

### 4 Minack Theatre

A world-famous, open-air amphitheatre dramatically carved into granite cliffs overlooking spectacular Porthcurno Bay, hosting plays, musicals and concerts.

### 5 Eureka Escape Cornwall

Immersive, real-life escape room experiences where teams are locked in themed rooms and given 60 minutes to escape.

### 6 Watersports

Make the most of Cornwall's amazing beaches and rivers with sailing, surfing, kite surfing, kayaking and boat trips.

### 7 Penzance

A historic, vibrant port town with a bohemian feel, a temperate climate, subtropical gardens and striking Georgian/Regency architecture.

### 8 Falmouth

A vibrant, creative and historic port, famous for having the world's third-deepest natural harbour – combining maritime history with modern creativity, beaches and seafood.

### 9 Barbara Hepworth Museum and Sculpture Garden

The preserved 20<sup>th</sup> Century sculptor's studio and garden containing her bronze works as she placed them.

### 10 Tate St Ives

An iconic art gallery celebrating modern and contemporary art. On the site of a former gasworks, the striking seaside venue doubles as a showcase for 20<sup>th</sup> Century British art.

## Walk

A good walking route is via the sand dunes leading to the coastal path. For safety, please use the rear gate to reach the beach.

## Cycle

The Coast to Coast Trail runs from Portreath to Devoran, through the Poldice Valley and Restrouquet Creek.

The nearest National Cycle Network route is 3: The Engine House Trail, part of the Cornish Way.
