1 Wroxham Barns

An award-winning family attraction offering hands-on animal encounters, a fun park with indoor and outdoor play and a unique independent Shopping Village.

2 Pleasurewood Hills

Family-friendly theme park, with over 35 rides and a soft play area. A great value, shorter-queue alternative to other parks.

3 Fairhaven Woodland and Water Garden

A haven of peace and tranquillity, this 136 acres of protected natural habitat is dedicated to conservation, education and wellbeing.

4 RAF Air Defence Radar Museum

At a former RAF base and in an original radar operations building this award-winning attraction details the history of radar and air defence from WWII to the Cold War.

5 BeWILDerwood

A huge woodland adventure park based on a series of children's books by Tom Blofeld. There are treehouses, zipwires, jungle bridges, massive slides, boat trips, marsh walks and great food!

6 Open Water Swimming

Guided experiences in the chilly North Sea for endurance swimmers and those looking to enjoy the open water with a safety boat on hand.

7 Thrigby Hall Wildlife Gardens

A family-friendly wildlife park with animals including tigers, snow leopards and red pandas – famous for its elevated treetop walkways and a close-up Tiger Tunnel.

8 Norwich

A vibrant city in touch with today's world, but steeped in history and overflowing with culture with the River Wensum at its heart.

Walk

The Broads National Park is Britain's largest protected wetland, with unique wildlife and over 190 miles of footpaths and nature trails.

Cycle

Follow the Norfolk Coast Cycleway with regular route markers.

The nearest National Cycle Network route travels in part through Great Yarmouth, route 1: connecting Norwich and Lowestoft. The Regional Route 30 is also nearby and forms a coastal loop.
