## **Arrival and Reception**

#### **Approach Route**

- Access onto the site is via a two way tarmac driveway, which runs through the site, to the reception building
- The reception building is towards the north of the site, the driveway leads directly to the reception building
- There is no entrance barrier to the site
- The ground is level in this area with hard surfaced paths linking facilities.

#### **Parking**

- A new arrival lane is set within a few metres of the Reception building, around a small roundabout allowing for more arrivals and ensuring that vehicles are facing the correct direction once they have checked in
- There is a visitor parking area behind reception, on loose stone chippings, with space for 4 vehicles
- There are 3 Late Night Arrival Bays, with electric hook ups

#### **Entrance into Reception**


- There is a dropped kerb, which gives access to a 1000mm wide ramped footpath with a 950mm x 1700mm level landing at the top of the ramp. There is a weather canopy over the path
- The Entrance door is 750mm wide over a 20mm threshold
- The entrance door is not power assisted, and opens inwards





## Reception

- The clear space is approximately 2400mm x 4100mm, but narrows to 1200mm between the wall and desk at the further end of the room
- The reception desk is set 880mm above the floor and incorporates a dropped section at 780mm high
- The desk is not fitted with a hearing loop



# **Getting around the Site**

- The site has a gentle incline throughout, but is fairly level
- Pedestrians share vehicles routes which are well maintained tarmac, but do incorporate speed bumps



#### **Pitches**

- There are 119 pitches on site, all of which are hardstanding
- Temporary multipurpose access rubber matting is not provided
- There are 14 designated accessible pitches, these pitches are allocated according to your needs or preference, so please contact us in advance to discuss your requirements.
- 5 of the designated pitches are between 60 metres to 100 metres from reception and 15 metres to 55 metres from the toilet block
- 9 of the designated pitches are between 100 metres to 150 metres from reception and 10 metres to 40 metres from the toilet block
- Pitches are allocated according to your needs or preference, so please contact the site in advance to discuss your requirements.

## **Toilets and Changing Facilities**

Accessible Toilets and Bathing Facilities – Toilet Block

- A combined Accessible Toilet and Shower cubicle is located in the Toilet Block which is set in the middle of the site
- The toilet block is on a level ground and can be accessed via dropped kerbs to the path, which are slightly sloped
- The door is 850mm wide, over a level threshold and opens outwards
- The cubicle door is secured by a RADAR key. Which can be borrowed from Reception
- The cubicle's overall dimensions are 2500mm x 1800mm
- The WC pan is right hand transfer.
- There is no drop down shower seat, however a moveable shower chair is provided
- The toilet seat is 480mm above the floor level
- The clear space to the side of the toilet is 600mm wide
- The cubicle is fitted with a pull cord alarm, which is tested frequently
- The shower seat and WC Pan are fitted with grab rails to assist transfer
- Shower controls are 900mm high
- The shower head is fitted on a sliding rail, which is a minimum of 1300mm above floor level

The basin taps and shower controls are fitted with levers



#### **Standard Toilets and Washrooms**

- There is one toilet and shower block in the middle of the site
- Parking is available next to Toilet Block
- Entrance doors are accessed by a paved area
- The male and female toilets have 750mm wide doors that opens inwards
- In the female toilets there are 9 WC Cubicles, 7 Privacy Washbasin Cubicles and
   6 Shower Cubicles
- In the male toilets there are 5 Urinals, 5 WC Cubicles, 8 Privacy Washbasin Cubicles and 6 Shower Cubicles
- Both of the male and female areas include a modified WC Cubicle, a modified
   Privacy Washbasin Cubicle and a modified Shower Cubicle for ambulant disabled people.
- 4 of the Shower Cubicles, including the modified shower cubicles, in both male and female toilets have a 60mm step between the wet and the dry areas. 2 of the Shower Cubicles are level between the wet and the dry areas
- Taps in each block incorporate lever controls







# **Baby and Toddler Room - Toilet Block**

- The baby and toddler room is accessed via a paved area around the toilet block
- The door is 750mm wide and over a level threshold and opens inwards
- The rooms dimensions are 2250mm x 2250mm, with a 1500mm turning circle internally
- The WC is 430mm above the ground
- There is a half sized bathtub with a shower over the top, with lever grip taps
- There is a changing surface at 550mm high
- There is a wall mounted, drop down baby changing table at 900mm high





#### **Other Facilities**

**Dishwashing – Toilet Block** 

Level approach via paved area



- The door is 750mm wide over a level threshold and opens inwards
- There are 4 sinks at 850mm high with 650mm knee space
- All of the sinks have lever taps



#### **Laundry – Toilet Block**

- Level access via paved area
- The door is 850mm wide over a small lip at the threshold, and opens outwards
- The door requires a key to access, which can be borrowed from reception with a key lock at 1600mm high
- There is approximately 1900mm x 1300mm clear space
- There is one top loading washing machine and one front loading tumble dryer
- The token slots are at 1050mm high for the machines
- There are 2 sinks at 850mm high with 650mm knee space beneath
- Lever taps are fitted

#### Information Room - Reception Building

- Access via the path with dropped kerbs, around reception
- The door is 750mm wide over a 20mm lip at the threshold and opens inwards
- There is 1700mm x 2000mm clear space internally
- Information is displayed on shelves at 600mm and 1000mm high



## **Old Telephone Booths - Inside The Information Room**

- There are 2 small booths inside of the information room, previously used for telephones, that now house a variety of books, games and information
- The openings to each are 600mm wide
- Each booth is only 700mm x 700mm





#### **Games Room**

- Within a building adjacent to reception
- There is access via a sloped roadway, and a dropped kerb
- The door opens to 800mm wide, over a 100mm threshold and opens inwards
- The room is very large and allows a minimum of 1000mm wide spaces between equipment
- There is a variety of table top game tables available, please ask at reception for more information









### Play Area and Picnic Area

- There is a play area in a north west field of the site
- This can be accessed via a large double gate
- The area is a large grass field with picnic tables, the grass does slope slightly



## Dog Field

- There is a large dog field to the east of the site
- This can be accessed via a 900mm wide gate, with a latch at 1100mm high
- The field is grass, sloping and can be uneven
- There are dog walks to the north and the south of the site





#### **Service Points**

- There are Service Points at intervals around the site, please check the site map for details
- All of the service points are on concrete settings, with level to access them from adjacent roadways
- The paths around the Service Points can be as narrow as 600mm wide
- The water taps are at a maximum of 750mm high, with cross head taps
- Chemical Emptying Points can be found here too with taps at 1100mm high and ledges at 480mm high



#### **Motorhome Service Point**

- There is one Motorhome Service Point on site, located close to the toilet block
- The taps are 1130mm above a 60mm high kerb





### **Recycling & Waste Area**

 This site has a single waste and recycling area, please consult the Site Map for its specific location. If you have any concerns or questions please discuss with the site team during your stay.
