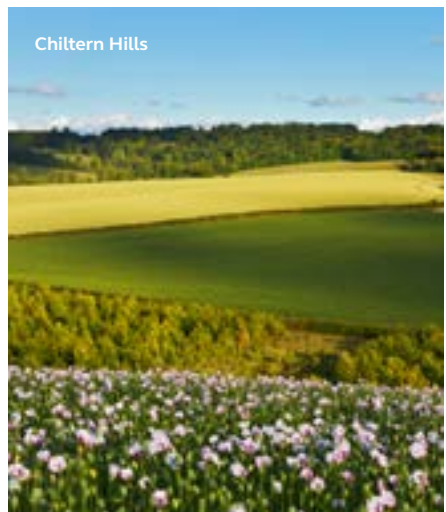
Chiltern Hills

There is a towpath along the Hambledon Lock, perfect for a 'stretch of the legs'.

Take a picnic and spend an afternoon people watching by the river in Henley.

Take a visit to Windsor, the castle is a must.

Try the real ale trail for a good introductory, informative walk around the town.

Nuffield Place (NT), previously the home of William Morris is a really interesting visit.

Visit Marlow, an attractive town on the River Thames offering riverside walks and a centre vibrant with shops, restaurants, pubs and cafes.
