## Visit

- 1 Hillside Animal Sanctuary**  
 Providing sanctuary for over 3,000 rescued animals including horses, ponies, donkeys.
- 2 Felbrigg Hall**  
 17th century country house with Jacobean architecture, Georgian interior, garden and estate.
- 3 BeWILDerwood**  
 Explore Norfolk's wild landscape. Take boat rides, build dens, dress up and enjoy story telling.
- 4 RNLI Henry Blogg Museum**  
 Celebrating the most decorated lifeboatman in RNLI history, who with his crew, saved over 873 lives from the North Sea.

- 5 North Norfolk Railway**  
 A heritage steam railway in running between the coastal towns of Sheringham and Holt.
- 6 The Big Shoot**  
 Enjoy the hilariously fun and competitive thrills that Clay Pigeon Shooting provides!

## Walk

- 7 The Norfolk Coast Path**  
From Hunstanton to Sea Palling through the dramatic landscape of the Norfolk Coast Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. Experience seaside towns and villages, tidal marshes teeming with wildlife, wide sandy beaches, pine woodlands and huge skies.

- 9 Cromer**  
A traditional seaside town with beautiful beaches, great museums and surfing.
- 10 Sheringham**  
Home to an award-winning beach, scenic promenade and a popular market.
- 11 Wells-next-the-Sea**  
One of the coast's most attractive towns, home to a gorgeous harbour, boutique shops and long, sweeping beach.

## Cycle

- 8 Local routes**  
Bikes can be hired in Cromer and Sheringham. From Cromer you can join National cycle Route 30 or cycle along the country lanes in the local area.





## Visitor's top tips

|| Visit The Village Inn for a good pint and a bite to eat – it's dog friendly too.

You can walk to both Cromer and Sheringham and there is a great bus service along the coast and inland.

A walk to the top of Ingleboro Hill is a must for fabulous sunset views.

Visit in spring – bluebells and yellow gorse galore!

Muckleburgh Military Collection is a very interesting visit. We loved walking our dog through the nearby woodland.

Sheringham Theatre hosts some excellent shows – be sure to check their schedule.

RSPB Titchwell Marsh is a lovely, and we had a wonderful day out on the North Norfolk Steam Railway too.

Head to Blakeney Point to see seals and seal pups – it's a breath-taking sight!
