10 Kendal


This historic and characterful market town is home to lots of intriguing sites.

Ideal for walking – routes are well marked from the site, and Windermere is within easy reach.

National Trust rangers lead walks on site around the disused gunpowder works throughout the summer.

If you're a birdwatcher make sure you see the Ospreys at Foulshaw Moss Nature Reserve, and visit the RSPB sites at both Leighton Moss and Millam.

The Brewery Arts Centre in Kendal offered wonderful shows, a comedy club and a cinema.

Lancaster Castle is a fantastic visit!

We had a couple of lovely meals at the Strickland Arms, and Low Sizergh Barn Farm Shop (15-minute walk) was great.

Throughout the year, there are some unmissable events and festivals in Kendal, including the Walking Festival and Lakes Alive.

There are lots of lovely dog-friendly eateries and cafes in the area.

We took a ferry trip across Lake Windermere which was very beautiful.
