Arrival and Reception

Approach Route

- Access onto the site is via a tarmac driveway
- The reception building is on the left hand side when you enter the site
- The gate from the road is left open during the day, it is closed between 8pm and
 9am but it is not locked so access is still available
- The ground is level in this area with hard surfaced paths linking facilities.

Parking

- A new arrival bay is set within a few metres of the Reception building.
- There is a small visitor car park with space for 5 vehicles, opposite reception,
 with no designated disabled bay
- There are no late night arrival bays

Entrance into Reception

- There are two steps to reception, the first is 50mm high and the second is
 120mm high
- The Entrance door is 750mm wide, over a 100mm threshold
- The entrance door is not power assisted, and opens inwards
- There is no call bell at the entrance





Reception

- There is approximately 1350mm x 2100mm turning space, clear of the desk and furniture
- The reception desk is set 900mm above the floor but does not include a dropped section
- The desk is not fitted with a hearing loop
- There are some items for sale in reception, which are all at the desk level





Getting around the Site

- The site is generally set relatively level throughout
- Pedestrians share vehicles routes which are well maintained tarmac roads and gravel areas surrounding the pitches, but do incorporate speed bumps

Pitches

- There are 61 pitches on site, 56 of which are hardstanding
- Roll out mats are not provided
- There are no designated accessible pitches, however pitches are allocated according to your needs or preference, so please contact us in advance to discuss your requirements.
- There are 5 hardstanding pitches which are approximately 15 metres to 25 metres from the Accessible WC

Camping Pitches

- There are 5 camping pitches on site
- All of the camping pitches are non-electric

Toilets and Changing Facilities

Accessible Toilets and Bathing Facilities - Toilet Block

- A combined Accessible Toilet and Shower cubicle is located in the Toilet Block which is close to the reception building
- The accessible facilities are accessed via a long wooden ramp with a level landing
- The door is 850mm wide, over a level threshold, and opens outwards
- The cubicle door is secured by RADAR key. A key can be borrowed from Reception
- The cubicle's overall dimensions are 2200mm x 2900mm
- The WC pan is left hand transfer.
- The shower seat is right hand transfer
- The toilet seat is 480mm, and the shower seat is 520mm above the floor level

- The clear space to the side of the toilet is 1200mm wide
- The cubicle is fitted with a pull cord alarm, which is tested frequently
- The shower seat and WC Pan are fitted with grab rails to assist transfer



- Shower controls are 1000mm high
- The shower head is fitted on a sliding rail, which is a minimum of 1200mm above floor level
- The basin taps and shower controls are fitted with levers



Standard Toilets and Washrooms

- There is one toilet and shower block which is close to the reception building
- There is no parking available near the toilet block
- Entrance doors to the male and female facilities are accessed by individual sets of stairs to each
- The female area has 4 WC cubicles, 4 Shower cubicles and 2 Privacy Washbasin cubicles
- The male area has 3 WC cubicles, 4 Shower cubicles and 2 Privacy Washbasin cubicles
- There is a modified WC, Shower and Privacy Washbasin cubicle in each area,
 with grab rails to assist with mobility

Other Facilities

Dishwashing – Facilities Block

- There is a facilities block with the dishwashing room, laundry room and drying room, close to pitches 13 and 14
- The door opens to 700mm wide with a 120mm step in and opens outwards
- There is 900mm x 2950mm clear space in front of the sinks
- There are 3 sinks at 900mm high with no kneespace underneath
- Twist turn taps available









Laundry – Facilities Block

- The laundry room is within the facilities block
- The door opens to 700mm wide with a 120mm step in
- There is 1800mm x 3700mm manoeuvring space
- There is one front loading washing machine and one front loading tumble dryer
- There are 2 sinks at 900mm high with 800mm knee space below
- Twist turn taps fitted



Drying Room - Facilities Block

- There is a drying room next to the laundry room, with an adjoining door inside and an external door to access
- The external door opens to 700mm wide with a 120mm step in
- The adjoining door opens to 750mm wide
- The room has 2650mm x 3600mm manoeuvring space
- There is a drying rack 1800mm high
- There is a bench at 520mm high





Drying Room

Information Room - Opposite Reception

- The information room is within a shed opposite reception
- The door is 700mm wide over a 120mm step
- The room's dimensions are 1100mm x 1900mm
- Information is displayed on a 900mm shelf







Dog Walk

- There is a dog walk on site to the North West of the site
- The ground to the dog walk is grass and can be uneven in places



Service Points

- There are Service Points at intervals around the site, please check the site map for details
- All of the service points are on concrete settings, with level access from the adjacent roadways
- The paths around the Service Points can be as narrow as 700mm wide
- The water taps are at a maximum of 750mm high, with cross head taps
- Chemical Waste Points can be found at some of the service points, please check the site map for details





Motorhome Waste Point

- There is one Motorhome Waste Point on site, located opposite the reception
- The taps are 1000mm high

- Please ask at reception if you have difficulty reading third party leaflets and staff
 will be happy to read these to you upon request
