Things to do

1 Attadale Gardens

On the southern shore of Loch Carron, the grounds feature a Japanese garden, water gardens with Monet bridges and sculptures among century-old rhododendrons.

2 Beinn Eighe National Nature Reserve

Ranging from the shores of Loch Maree to the rugged mountain peaks of the Beinn Eighe ridge, showcasing scree slopes, pine forests and diverse alpine wildlife.

3 Gairloch Marine Life Centre and Cruises

Offering scenic and wildlife cruises around Gairloch. Spot harbour porpoises, whales, seals, dolphins, otters and seabirds.

4 Inverewe Garden

A spectacular botanical oasis on the rugged north-west coast. With a unique microclimate allowing exotic plants including Tasmanian eucalyptus and Himalayan blue poppies to thrive.

5 Hiking

Dramatic landscapes with deep glens and shimmering lochs to towering mountain peaks, on strenuous multi-day treks or a scenic day hike for all fitness levels.

6 Torridon Estate

A majestic Highland wilderness defined by 750 million-year-old sandstone peaks – a premier destination for outdoor enthusiasts seeking world-class mountain adventures.

7 Applecross Peninsula

A remote and tranquil sanctuary, famous for coastal scenery, wildlife and the Bealach na Bà mountain pass, with views of the Inner Sound and the Isles of Skye and Raasay.

8 Shieldaig

A whitewashed conservation village overlooking Loch Shieldaig and the pine-covered Shieldaig Island. A tranquil holiday base renowned for mountain backdrops, wildlife and exceptional local seafood.

Walk

Local walks for all fitness levels are available directly from the site, from a 1.5k stroll to the Beinn Eighe Visitor Centre to much more challenging mountain hikes.

For a challenging but rewarding hike, trek up Mount Slioch for stunning views of Loch Maree.

Cycle

The nearest National Cycle Network route is 1: the Lochs and Glens north route. The route can be picked up at Dingwall.

The Heights of Kinlochewe route starts from the site's doorstep and many other routes, including the Torridon loop, are within a 10-20 mile radius.
