





## Walk

### 8 Local Walks

There are several footpaths in the local area including the Abbey Road Sculptures and Knaresborough Castle walk, a 3 mile walk from the centre of town to the castle, via a trail of fascinating woodland sculptures.

### 9 River Nidd Waterside Walk

Starting at the riverside car park, you can take various length circular walks, ideal for families, strollers, amblers or serious hikers.

## Cycle

### 10 National Cycle Network

The nearest National Cycle Network route to this site is route number 67, York to Harrogate.

### 11 Beryl Burton Way

From Knaresborough to Ripley on a largely traffic free path. The route is a 10 mile ride in total with refreshments available at Ripley.



## Explore

### 12 Yorkshire Dales

A national park famous for its glorious scenery; from deep valleys, rolling hills, lush meadows and heather-carpeted moorland.

### 13 Harrogate

An elegant spa town home to Edwardian architecture and pretty English gardens.

### 14 York

A walled city lined with medieval streets and rich in fascinating history.



## Visitor's top tips

Don't miss a day or two exploring the Yorkshire Dales, the scenery will take your breath away!

Walk to Knaresborough via the gorge, wander along the waterside and enjoy views of the iconic viaduct and castle.

Betty's Tea Room in Harrogate is excellent.

Fountains Abbey is well worth a visit, with space to park your motorhome.

York is a lovely city offering so much to see and do, from fascinating museums to independent shops and eateries.
