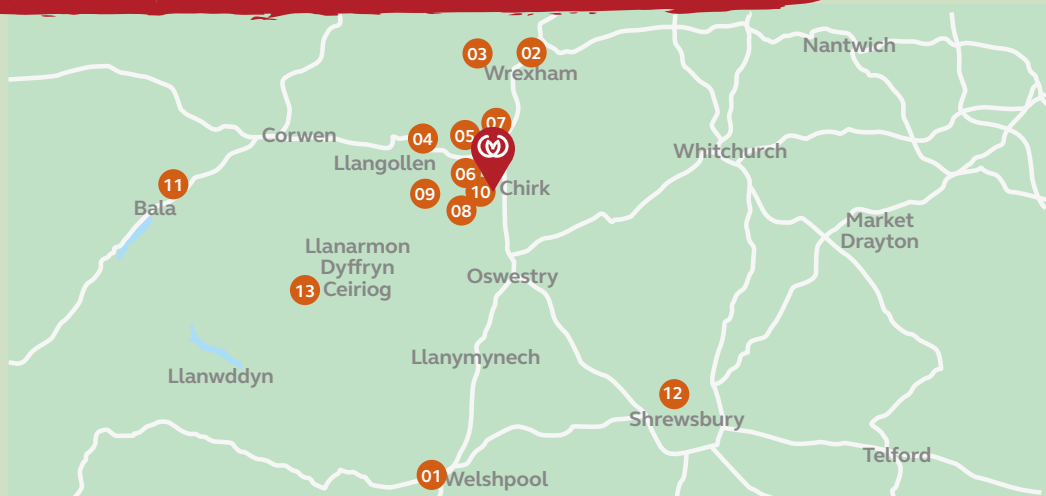

- 4 Llangollen Railway**  
Runs along the banks of the river Dee, from Llangollen to Carrog.
- 5 Pontcysyllte Aqueduct and Trevor Basin Visitor Centre**  
UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the most awesome engineering feats on the canal network.
- 6 Seg Trek**  
A fun and exciting segway experience set in the grounds of Chirk Castle.
- 7 Gorge Walking**  
Grab a wetsuit and explore the gorges of North Wales from a unique perspective with enthusiastic and qualified guides.

## Walk

### 8 Offa's Dyke Way

Follows the English/Welsh border for 177 miles alongside the 8th Century Offa's Dyke. Offering amazing opportunities to see native wildlife.

### 9 Ceiriog Valley

Marked walks start from Chirk to explore the valley.



## Cycle

### 10 Canal Towpaths

Great cycling along the towpaths next to the site.

### 11 Bala

Historic market town in the Snowdonia National Park, famous for white-water canoeing, swimming, cycling and triathlons on and around its lake.

### 12 Shrewsbury

Shropshire's county town, on the banks of the River Severn.

### 13 Pistyll Rhaeadr

The highest waterfall in Wales.



# Visitor's top tips

Pistyll Rhaeadr

*Visit Berwyn Mountains and Pistyll Rhaeadr, the highest waterfall in Wales.*

*Walk or cycle along the Llangollen canal to Chirk Aqueduct or to Pontcysytle Aqueduct the other. Both feats of engineering designed and built by Thomas Telford.*

*The Iron Age Fort at Oswestry is an interesting day out.*

*The walk to Chirk Castle is lovely through the sheep field and the woods, then around the grounds.*

*Visit in spring to see the beautiful bluebells.*

*We enjoyed climbing Dinas Bran in Llangollen, there are fantastic views.*

*Oswestry is a nice market town and Wrexham is good to visit and easy to get to by train.*

*We enjoyed the Shropshire Sculpture Park in Oswestry.*

*The local butchers in the town has great local produce with a fantastic greengrocers next door.*

*Chester was an interesting place to visit with it's Roman history, wonderful shops. and a great river cruise.*
