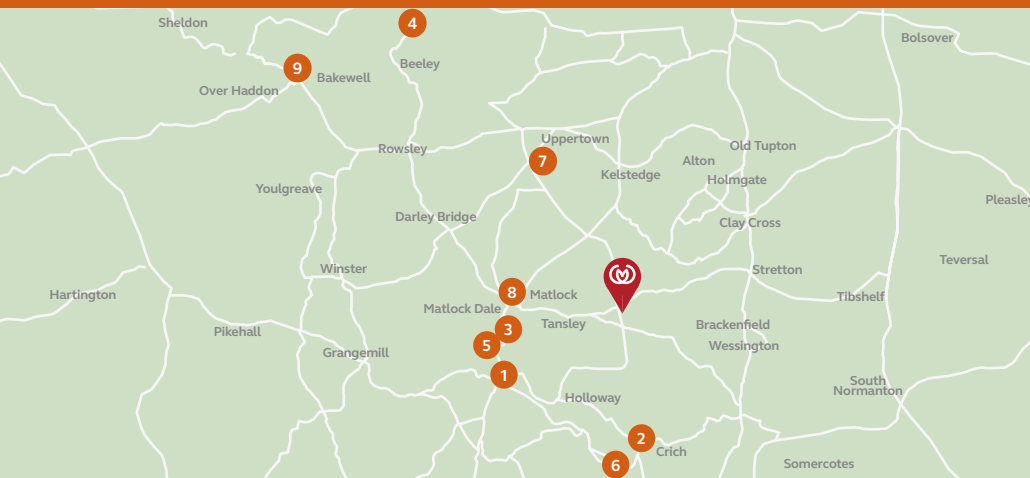

Things to do

- 1 Cromford Mill**
A UNESCO World Heritage site housing the world's first water powered cotton spinning mill built by Sir Richard Arkwright in 1771.
- 2 National Tramway Museum**
An open-air museum featuring a reconstructed period street with a working tramway – travel on vintage trams into the countryside.
- 3 Heights of Abraham**
A unique hilltop park reached by cable car from Matlock Bath, with fabulous views over the Derwent Valley, woodland trails, cave tours and a panoramic restaurant.
- 4 Chatsworth House**
A magnificent English country house providing a captivating blend of grandeur, natural beauty and layered history. With 4,000 years of art, 105 acres of gardens and an expansive parkland.
- 5 Peak District Mining Museum**
Exploring the gruelling history of lead mining from Roman times to the 20th Century. Featuring immersive indoor exhibits and underground mine and tunnel tours.
- 6 Great British Car Journey**
An interactive museum celebrating the golden age of British motoring, featuring a timeline of British-built cars that changed the world.
- 7 Matlock Farm Park**
A popular, family-friendly attraction offering hands-on animal encounters with wallabies, meerkats, llamas and goats and outdoor adventures and play areas.
- 8 Matlock**
A charming, scenic town on the edge of the Peak District National Park, acting as a hub for visitors exploring the surrounding countryside.
- 9 Bakewell**
A charming, historic market town on the banks of the River Wye, famous for the famous Bakewell Pudding.

Walk

The Peak District National Park, Britain's first National Park, offers outstanding walking, as well as some of England's finest climbing, cycling and caving.

Cycle

An excellent base for exploring the Peak District on two wheels.

There is the Lickpenny Campsite Loop – a 23-mile circular loop from site, the Derwent Valley Route – an easy 5-mile route along the river Derwent and the High Peak Trail – a 17-mile traffic free run along a former railway.

The nearest National Cycle Network route to site is: The Monsal Trail, between Chee Dale and Bakewell.

Site access restrictions:

- ✓ Barrier code/fob issued on arrival

Accessing the facilities

Facility access restrictions:

- ✓ Key operated door lock on the accessible room

Connectivity

- ✓ Mobile phone signal – poor. Mobile phone signal may vary depending on network provider
- ✓ TV reception – pitch dependent and varies
- ✓ Wi-Fi – waiting for wifi roll out. Currently only part of the site has free wifi

- ✓ Some machines are operated by contactless debit or credit card. These washing machine cycles are £5 and a 15 minute tumble dryer cycle is £1.25
- ✓ Other machines are coin operated. These washing machine cycles are £4, pre-wash is £1 and a 15 minute tumble dryer cycle is £1
