8 South Downs National Park

Join the South Downs Way which runs for 100 miles between Winchester and Eastbourne, and enjoy the views, wildlife and history.

The South Coast cycle route is flat by the sea from Ferring in the east to Runcton in the west.

11 Salterns Way

Starting in Central Chichester, this 12 mile route will take you to West Wittering and the sand dunes of East Head.

Visitor's top tips

There is a pub less than 5 minutes walk away.

Don't miss Littlehampton Harbour. On a sunny day it's lovely to sit on the harbourside.

There's a great dog exercise area on site.

Only the locals know about Climping Beach and its car park. Some days you could almost have a beach to yourself!

Mewsbrook Cafe in Littlehampton is lovely, serving delicious food, snacks, tea and coffee – it's also dog-friendly.

Visit the Mary Rose Museum in Portsmouth.

Wander along the promenade and beach in Littlehampton, it's incredibly scenic, and lovely if you have a dog.

There are wonderful National Trust and English Heritage sites dotted around – we loved East Head and Boxgrove Priory near Chichester.

Gunwharf Quays in Portsmouth is excellent for shopping.

If you fancy fish & chips, head to Freds on the harbour.

A trip to Worthing is worthwhile, with a lovely pier, beautiful architecture and lots of shops and restaurants.

The Amberley Museum near Arundel is a great, very interesting day out!
