## **Visit**

1 Longleat

Get close to the animals at the UK's first safari park, or explore the house and gardens.

2 Stourhead House
A breathtaking 18th century

home, with world famous gardens.

The Roman Baths

The finest religious spa in Northern Europe, built 2000 years ago at Britain's only hot springs.

4 Stonehenge

The best known prehistoric monument in Europe.

5 Caving and Climbing

The word famous AONB Cheddar Caves and Gorge is an international centre for caving and rock climbing.

The nearest route is 24, Eastleigh to Dundas, which takes you to the historic market town of Frome.




## **Explore**



England's smallest city with a glorious Cathedral and impressive Bishop's Palace in its medieval centre.

11 Bath

A unique city which combines vibrant culture with a rich history. Immerse yourself in a remarkable collection of museums, galleries, theatres, year-round events and great music scene.





Visit Cley Hill for panoramic views of Wiltshire and Somerset.

Don't miss Frome Farmers Market at the Cheese and Grain Market Hall on the second Saturday of each month.

Nearby Lacock Abbey is an excellent day out – it was used as Hogwarts in two Harry Potter films.

The Royal Oak Pub is approximately two miles from the campsite - it offers excellent food, it's great for families and is dog-friendly too.

Chalk Hill and the Salisbury Plain are lovely areas to walk.

The famous Cheddar Gorge is fairly nearby (under an hour's drive), and makes for a wonderful day out.

There's a lovely tea room at Sheerwater Lake, which offers beautiful walking trails too.

Bradford-upon-Avon is a lovely little town with lots of interesting history.

If you fancy a day out on the coast, head to Weston-super-Mare.
