Enjoy a beautiful walk from the site to Heavens Gate with lovely views over the Longleat Estate. There are also walks from the site through woodland to the local dog friendly pubs, taking about 3/4 hour each way.

Cycling is recommended around the Longleat Estate.

9 National Cycle Network

The nearest route is 24, Eastleigh to Dundas, which takes you to the historic market town of Frome.



Visitor's TOP TIPS

Visit Cley Hill for panoramic views of Wiltshire and Somerset.

Don't miss Frome Farmers Market at the Cheese and Grain Market Hall on the 2nd Saturday of each month.

Nearby Lacock Abbey is an excellent day out - it was used as Hogwarts in two Harry Potter films.

The 1.5 mile walk to the The Horse and Groom in Frome works up an appetite and we had a lovely meal before doing the return journey.

The Royal Oak Pub offers excellent food - it's great for families and is dog-friendly too.


The famous Cheddar Gorge is fairly nearby (under an hour's drive), and makes for a wonderful day out.

Chalk Hill and the Salisbury Plain are lovely areas to walk.

There's a lovely tea room at Sheerwater Lake, which offers beautiful walking trails too.

Bradford-upon-Avon is a lovely little town with lots of interesting history.
