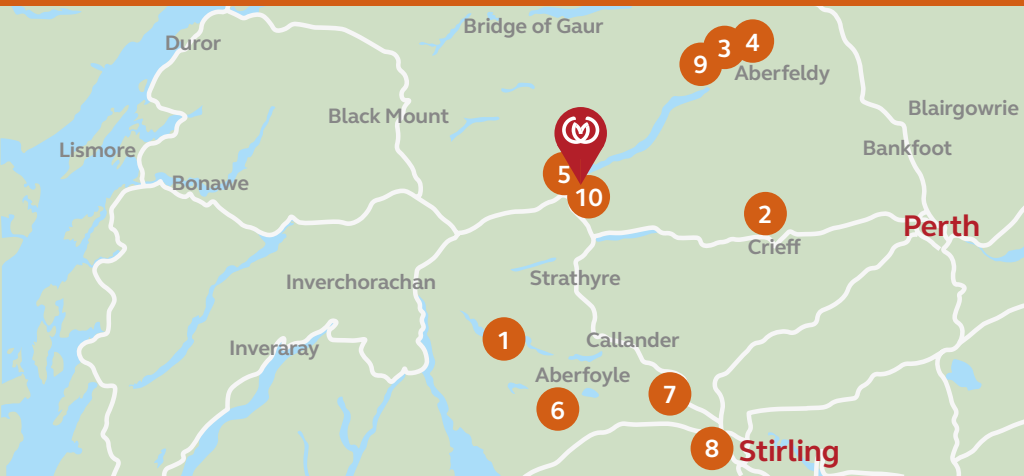

Things to do

- 1 Loch Katrine**
An iconic freshwater loch in breathtaking scenery, serving as the historic water supply for Glasgow and gateway to the Great Trossachs, to explore with a day trip cruise.
- 2 The Glenturret Distillery**
Scotland's oldest working distillery surrounded by the Turret River and rolling hills. It pairs traditional, small-batch whisky crafting with luxury Michelin-Starred offerings.
- 3 Highland Safaris**
Immersive Highland experiences via Landrover safaris, a Red Deer Centre for close encounters and boat safaris.
- 4 Castle Menzies**
A spectacular 16th Century Scottish Castle, serving as the historic seat of the Clan of Menzies.
- 5 Killin Golf Club**
Described as the most beautiful in Scotland, Killin is a challenging yet spectacular 9 hole course with natural hazards. Guests can borrow clubs for free from the club house.
- 6 Go Ape – Aberfoyle**
Self-paced adventure combining ziplines, obstacle course rope crossings, Tarzan Swings, set above the ground in the forest canopy.
- 7 Briarlands Farm**
An action-packed play experience for young children, complete with farm animal encounters, go karts, giant jumping pillows and tractor rides.
- 8 Stirling**
The Gateway to the Highlands, visit Stirling Castle, The National Wallace Monument and The Battle of Bannockburn Experience in this vibrant and scenic City.
- 9 Scottish Crannog Centre**
An immersive, award-winning openair museum and guided experience featuring a reconstructed Iron Age loch-dwelling.
- 10 Falls of Dochart**
A spectacular series of cascading rapids on the River Dochart, in the village of Killin at the western end of Loch Tay.

Walk

A walking route close to the site is towards Loch Tay, joining the old railway line through Killin.

Woodland walks, biking trails, route maps, bike hire, self-guided cycling and walking safaris are aplenty – information is available at reception.

Cycle

There are good cycle routes with spectacular views of the Ben Lawers mountain range.

The nearest National Cycle Network route to site is 7: Glasgow to Pitlochry – the Lochs and Glens Route North.

Site access restrictions:

- ✓ Barrier fob issued on arrival

Accessing the facilities

Facility access restrictions:

- ✓ Key operated door locks on the accessible room and the family room

Connectivity

- ✓ Mobile phone signal – good. Mobile phone signal may vary depending on network provider
- ✓ TV reception – fair. Booster system is available on pitches 14-33
- ✓ Club Wi-Fi. Premium wifi – *charges apply*. Free wifi to the pitch

In an emergency

Emergency out of hours contact information can be found on the reception door/window.

In the event of an evacuation, information can be found at reception and guidance displayed in the information room.

Laundry facilities

- ✓ Machines are token operated only. Tokens are available from reception at £1.25 each. All washing machine cycles are £5, pre-wash is £1.25 and a 15 minute tumble dryer cycle is £1.25
